Every year people are hurt and property is damaged because firecrackers are used improperly, according to firefighters.

Last Saturday, firecrackers were tossed out a second-floor downtown Stouffville window at about 3:45 p.m., Dep. Fire Chief Rob

McKenzie said.

A man told York Regional Police two people in his apartment had been involved in throwing firecrackers but they had left by the time officers arrived, according to police spokesperson Const. Laurie Perks.

The man was arrested for public intoxication and held until sober.

HOW TO SAFELY LAUNCH YOUR WEEKEND FIREWORKS

Whitchurch-Stouffville firefighters urge you to consider these safety tips if you are planning to use fireworks this weekend:

- **WHERE ARE THE KIDS?** Children should be supervised at all times and not handle or light fireworks
- **BOOZE-FREE:** Don't drink alcohol before or while lighting off fireworks
- **STAY CLEAR:** Keep the audience a safe distance away (a radius of 30 feet is required for Roman candles)
- **CANCELLED:** Don't fire in windy conditions

Vandorf sky to light up

To celebrate Victoria Day, fireworks by Stouffville's Pyro Mario will fill the sky Monday in Vandorf.

They're being presented at dusk at Vandorf Park on Woodbine Avenue south of Aurora Road.

Bring your lawn chairs, but, for safety reasons, don't bring your own fireworks. Sparklers, however, are allowed in the park.

More than 200 people usually come to watch the show every year.

The fireworks go on rain or shine, Michole Ongman, the town's recreation programmer and aquatic supervisor said.

The only thing that could put them into jeopardy is high winds.
