PUBLIC MEETING CONCERNING A PROPOSED ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will hold a Public Meeting under the authority of Section 34 of the Planning Act to consider an Amendment to General Zoning By-law 87-34 and General Zoning By-law 72-7 to introduce regulatory standards to govern Bed & Breakfast Establishments.

The Public Meeting will be convened on Tuesday June 19th, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. The Public Meeting will be held in the Council Chambers, Town Municipal Offices, 37 Sandiford Drive, 4th Floor, Stouffville.

The purpose of the Public Meeting will be to add regulatory standards to General Zoning By-law 87-34 and General Zoning By-law 72-7 to govern the creation of Bed & Breakfast Establishments within all Residential and Rural Zones. No map is attached to this Notice as this provision would potentially apply across the Town.

Any person may attend the Public Meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of, or in opposition to the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment. Should you be unable to attend the Public Meeting, your written submission will be received by the Town Clerk up to the time of the Public Meeting.

If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, you must make a written request to the Clerk at the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville, 37 Sandiford Drive, 4th Floor, Stouffville, Ontario L4A 7X5

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville in respect of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment does not make oral submissions at a Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville before the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

Additional information relating to the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, including a copy of the proposed Amendment, is available for inspection between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, at the Development Services Department, Town Municipal Offices, or by telephone at (905) 640-1900 or (905) 895-2423.

WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS FLUSHING PROGRAM COMMUNITIES OF BALLANTRAE/ MUSSELMAN LAKE AND STOUFFVILLE

The Public Works Department reminds residents that it conducts a major watermain flushing program of the Town's water distribution systems twice annually.

The next event is scheduled to begin on or about Monday May 28th, 2007 in the communities of Ballantrae/Musselman Lake and Stouffville and is expected to last for approximately three (3) weeks. The work is to be conducted daily, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:30 pm.

The process involves the flowing of fire hydrants for several minutes. The program will remove accumulated sediment from the systems. Some temporary discoloration may occur. The presence of this sediment does not pose a health hazard. Should anyone experience any discoloration of water, please let the water run until it clears. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

The program also allows Public Works crews the opportunity to check the operation of hydrants to ensure that they are in proper working order.

GREEN CORNER

In September, 2007, the Town will introduce source separated organics (Green Bins) to its waste management program with an important goal to reduce the amount of household waste diverted to landfill sites. Green Bins are used to separate organic waste from regular household waste, prior to introduction into the waste stream.

What types of things go in the Green Bin?

- Shredded and soiled paper
- Soiled food packaging such as pizza boxes
- Diapers
- Hair, nail clippings
- Sanitary products, tissues
- Animal waste, cat litter
- Food scraps, including meat products
- Baking ingredients, including eggs and shells
- Houseplants, including soil

What types of things do not go in the Green Bin?

- Fireplace or BBQ ashes, wood
- Cigarette butts, tobacco
- Gum
- Popsicle sticks and toothpicks
- Ear cleaners, cotton balls, make-up removal pads, dental floss
- Dryer lint, dryer sheets
- Baby wipes
- Vacuum cleaner bags and contents
- Recyclable materials
