### PUBLIC MEETING Concerning a Proposed Zoning By-Law Amendment

A Public Meeting under the authority of Section 34 of the Planning Act to consider an Amendment to General Zoning By-law 87-34 and General Zoning By-law 72-7 to introduce regulatory standards to govern Bed & Breakfast Establishments.

The purpose of the Public Meeting will be to add regulatory standards to General Zoning By-law 87-34 and General Zoning By-law 72-7 to govern the creation of Bed & Breakfast Establishments within all Residential and Rural Zones.

Any person may attend the Public Meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of, or in opposition to the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment. Should you be unable to attend the Public Meeting, your written submission will be received by the Town Clerk up to the time of the Public Meeting.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville in respect of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment does not make oral submissions at a Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville before the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

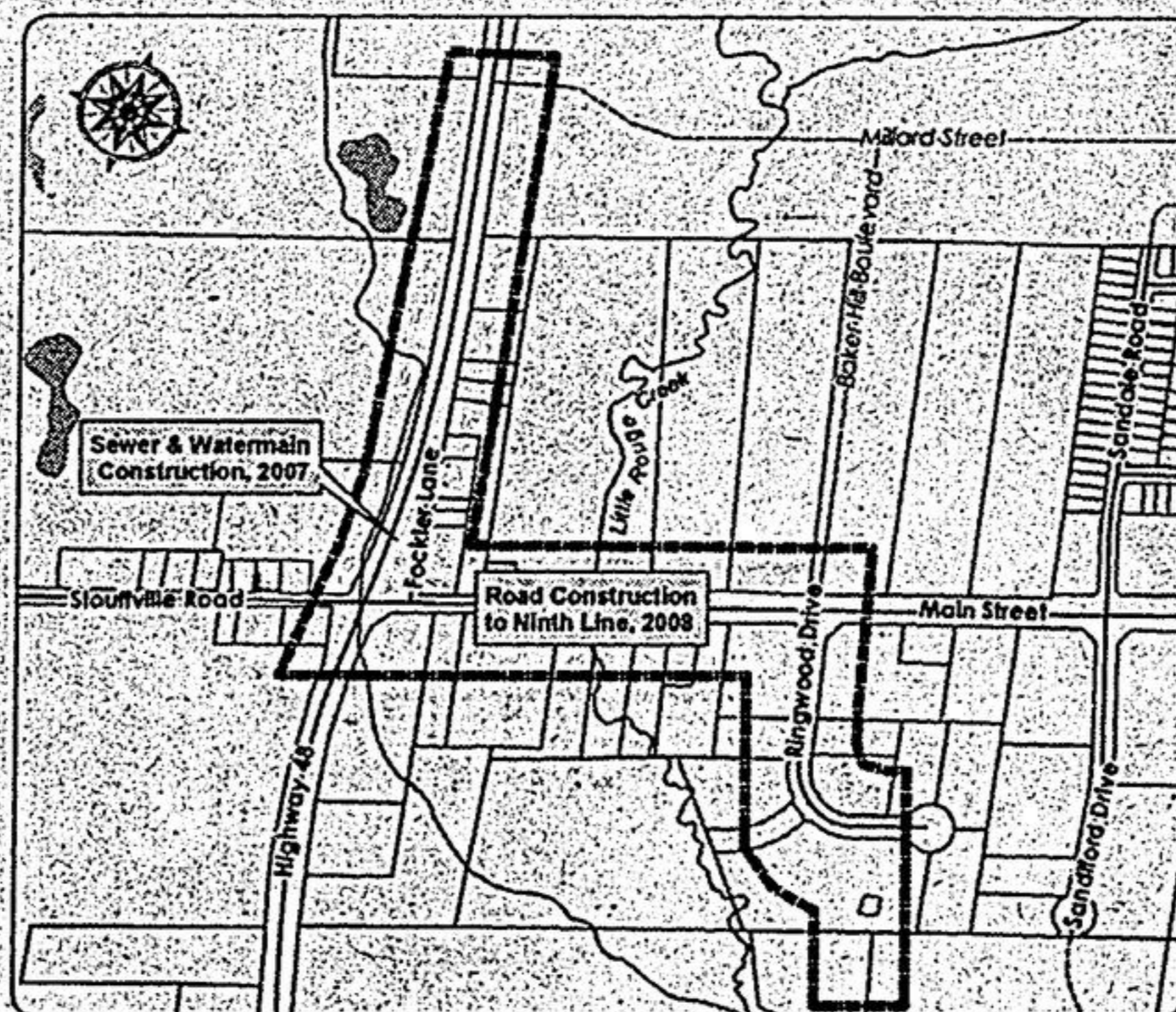

You are invited to attend the Open House to review the plans the Town has for construction work on Ringwood Drive, Main Street and Highway 48 in Stouffville. The Town is implementing significant roadway improvements to respond to planned growth in a responsible manner, including new arterial roads (Hoover Park Drive and Millard Street) and widening of Main Street - a project approved under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process.

Over the next two years, Main Street will be completely reconstructed from Highway 48 to the Ninth Line. The project has been designed to provide a balance between improved traffic operations and pedestrian safety. The new road will have two lanes for travel in each direction with a center left-turn lane and landscaped median.

Construction will begin July 2007 with stormwater system improvements between Ringwood Drive and Highway 48 as well as watermain and sanitary sewer construction. Road construction on Main Street will continue through 2008.
