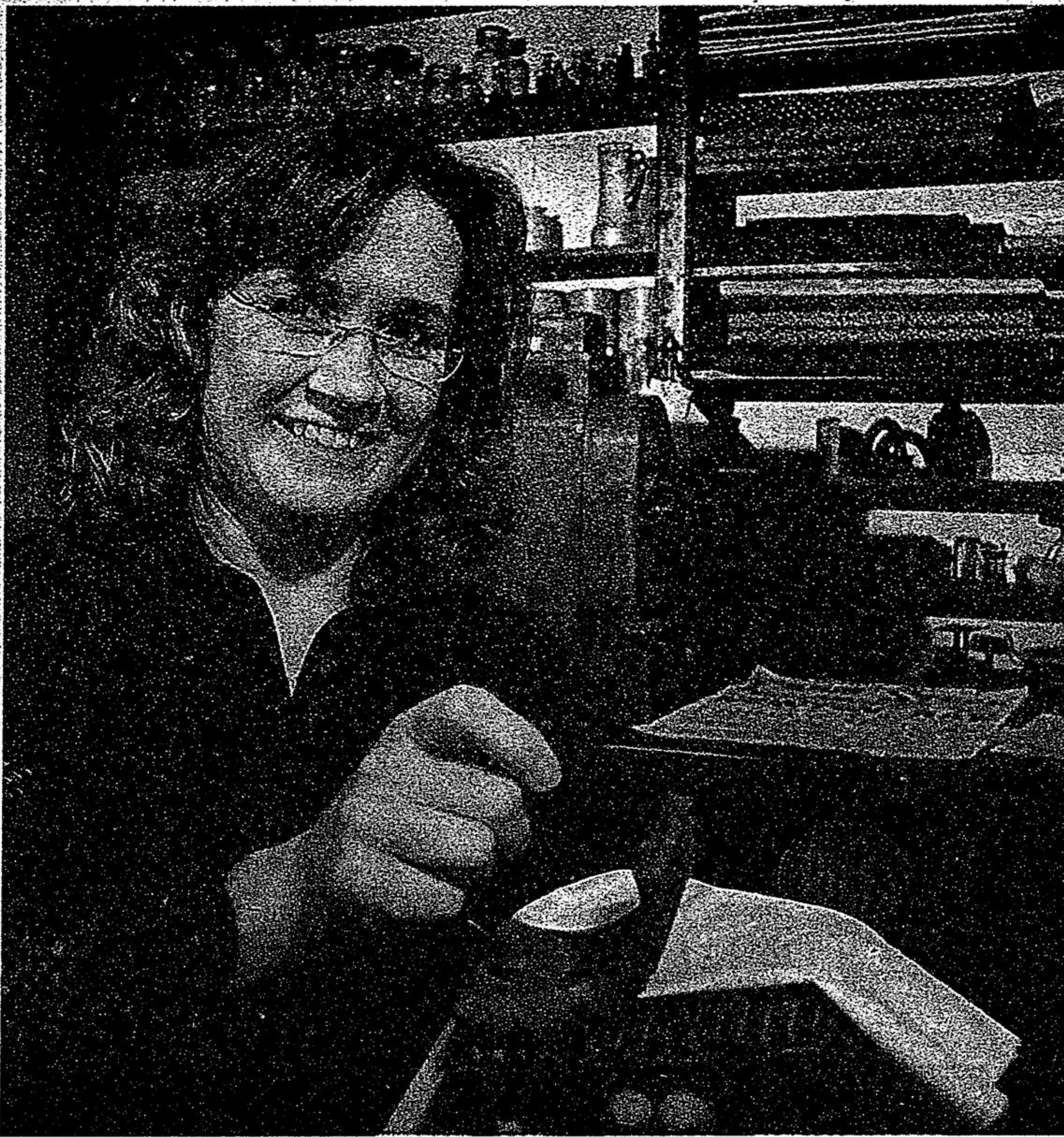


GOOD HOUSEKEEPING

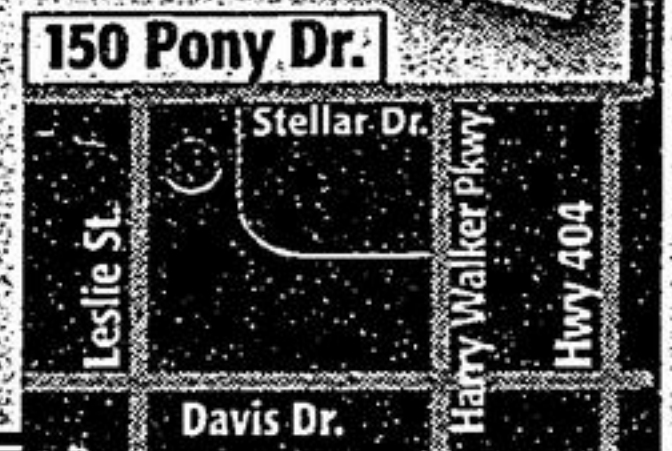
