

# Soccer girls edged out at provincials

The Stouffville District Secondary School Spartans girls soccer team encountered some tough luck in Wallaceburg Monday and Tuesday at the Ontario high school AA championships.

The Spartans opened play Monday with a 1-0 loss to third-seeded St. Thomas Aquinas (Oakville) and a 1-1 draw against No. 5 Ridgeway Crystal Beach High School.

Brittany Moreau scored the lone Spartans' goal.

The Spartans then played Holy Trinity Catholic High School (Bradford) Tuesday morning and held a 2-0 halftime lead before succumbing 3-2.

Jen Carroll and Moreau scored for the Spartans, who were eliminated from a berth in the playoffs with the loss.

The Spartans concluded pool play later in the day against Timmins High and Vocational School and battled to a 0-0 draw.

In tuning up for the OFSAA play-downs, the Spartans took part in a tournament last week at Father Bresciani Catholic High School in Woodbridge.

The Spartans advanced to the semifinals before suffering a 4-0 loss to St. Elizabeth Catholic High School (Thornhill).

Buoyed by two goals from Brittany Crago, the Spartans won their opening game over St. Joan of Arc Catholic High School (Barrie) 2-0.

The Spartans were then forced into playing two matches that each went into nine penalty kicks before emerging with victories over Pierre Elliott Trudeau 1-0 and Dr. J.F. Dennison Secondary School (Newmarket) 2-1.

Dayle Wilkinson scored the Spartans' goal in regulation time against Dr. J.F. Dennison.




