Main diamond to become 'showpiece'

The main ball diamond 1 in Memorial Park will become a 'showpiece' in the centre of town, Mayor Wayne Emmerson said.

Plans for Bethesda and Memorial parks, costing \$11.4 million if completed, were approved this week by town council.

Its historic grandstand will either be renovated or replaced, but its historical appearance will be maintained.

New in-fill materials will go on to the playing field, there will be a warning track around the outfield and a new fence is to be put up.

Mr. Emmerson envisions "a high-class, beautiful main diamond in the centre of our town so that softball can be played and it will be a pleasure to watch."

He's hoping construction can start at the end of the 2008 season so the diamond can be ready for 2009.
