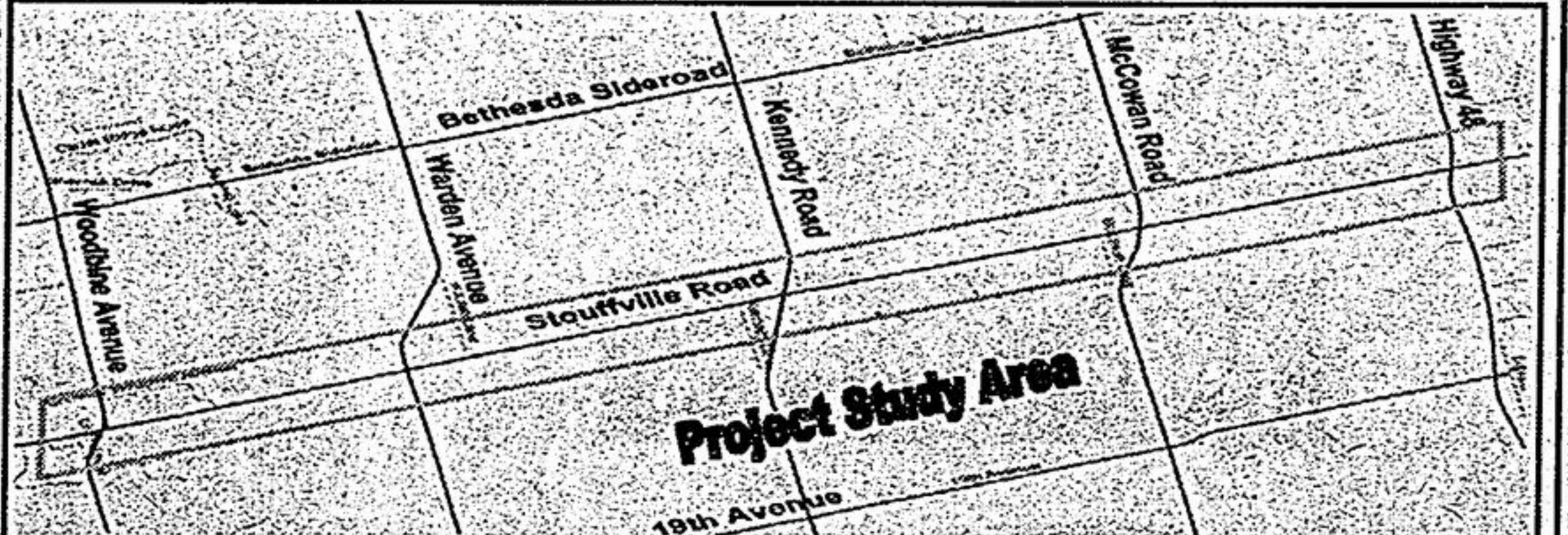

**CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT
STOUFFVILLE ROAD (Regional Road 14) IMPROVEMENTS
WOODBINE AVENUE TO HIGHWAY 48
Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville**

The Regional Municipality of York has completed a Class Environmental Assessment for improvements to Stouffville Road (Regional Road 14) from Woodbine Avenue to Highway 48 in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville.

The study has been conducted in accordance with Schedule C of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (June 2000) under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.



Subject to the comments received as a result of this Notice and the receipt of other approvals as necessary, The Regional Municipality of York intends to proceed with the detailed design and construction of this project.

The purpose of this project is to implement improvements to address identified capacity and operational deficiencies within the Stouffville Road corridor. The recommended design includes the widening of Stouffville Road from two to four lanes, the provision of turning lanes at sideroad intersections, vertical alignment improvements, drainage improvements and pavement rehabilitation.

A Schedule C Environmental Study Report has been prepared for this project. The Report describes the problem, the assessment of alternatives and the preferred solution, as well as the public and agency consultation program conducted during the Study.
