

Concert carries political tune

Stouffville musician Grainne Ryan is performing in the Taj Mahal-inspired Foster Memorial tomorrow.

She will also be airing her views opposing the proposed Pickering Airport by having pamphlets from the Land Over Landings Group at the concert.

Her views on the environment and social issues are evident in her music, as is her exploration of affairs of the heart.

Ms Ryan will sing selections from her

latest CD, *All the Money*, as well as a previous release *Maggie's Field*, produced with singer/songwriter Kim Brown.

At the concert, Ms Ryan will be accompanied by her sister, Cora Westermann, singing harmonies.

The show begins at 7:30 p.m. and is acoustic to take advantage of the building's excellent sound properties.

The Foster Memorial is near Leaskdale, about 10 minutes north of Uxbridge on Durham Rd. 1 (north of

Davis Drive).

It was built in 1936 by Thomas Foster, after being inspired by the Taj Mahal on a visit to India. The building's interior reflects a Byzantine style of architecture.

Ms Ryan will also perform at 66 On Brock, Brock St. Uxbridge, tonight, beginning at 9 p.m.
