

Another trophy for Storm

The Stouffville Storm bantam boys fielded the top prize at the Oshawa softball tournament after defeating Waterloo 5-1 in last Sunday's final.

The Storm were dominant in the tournament as they routed Newmarket 11-5, Oshawa 11-1 and Scarborough 19-1 in their round-robin matches last Saturday.

The following day, the Storm handed Waterloo its first loss in the double elimination tournament 5-1 to set the stage for the final match.

In York-Durham league play last Wednesday, the Storm suffered its first loss of the season to Oshawa 3-2.

"We used the tournament as a tuneup for the provincials," Storm head coach Mike Heffernan said of the Ontario Amateur Softball Association event Aug. 11-12 at Waterloo.

"Four of the teams we saw in Oshawa will be in our pool at the provincials," he said.

"But I thought we played solid throughout. Our sticks were hot. Everybody hit and we had good pitching. The boys had fun."

The Storm will play at the Eastern Canadian championships Aug. 23-26 in Torbay, Nfld., after winning the Ontario elimination event this month. It's their third straight trip to the tourney.
