

First of three fire trucks delivered

The red, shiny fire truck with a large 511 emblazoned on front is the Whitchurch-Stouffville Fire and Emergency Services' latest acquisition.

Featuring equipment for extricating accident victims from their vehicles, it was purchased for \$380,000 to replace an older truck.

Two more vehicles are on order for delivery next summer.

One will be a pumper/rescue vehicle and the other a pumper/tanker to be used for fighting fires in rural areas.

The pumper/rescue vehicle will replace a truck at the Ballantrae Fire Station while the other replaces a tanker truck at the downtown Stouffville station.
