# Arena, fire hall to open in 2009

June 2005 showed a new fire station in this area would mean the station in downtown Stouffville would have to be kept in service for proper coverage.

It costs \$1.5 million to \$1.8 million to operate a fire hall on a seven-day-a-week full-time basis with a minimum of four firefighters. The Weldon location means only one fire hall is needed to serve Stouffville.

The more central location gives firefighters easier access to the west end of town, as well as to develop-

ments south of Main, Mr. Emmerson said.

Designs for the fire hall are expected to be completed late this year or early next

year and we are hoping to break ground next year, Mr. Emmerson said.

A 2009 completion date is anticipated for the fire hall.

It hasn't been decided whether to build the new arena with one or two ice pads.

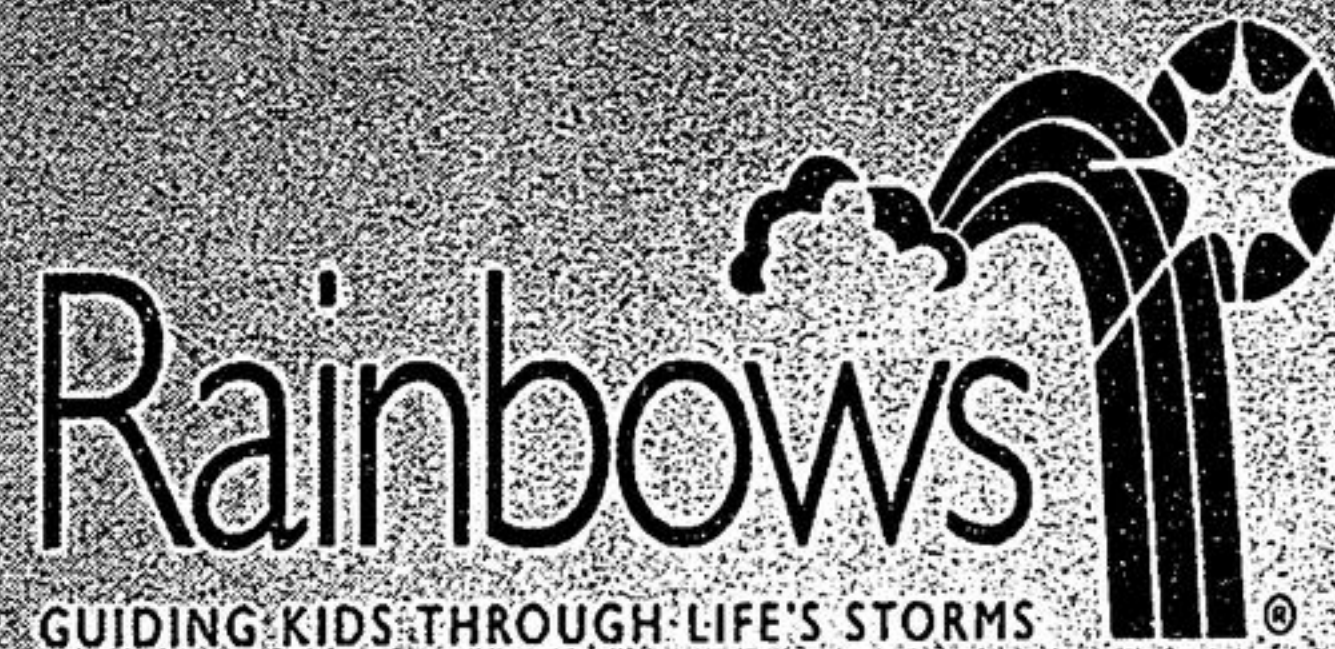
Tenders are going out shortly to see which method of construction would be the best and most cost-effective.

"I think it would be beneficial to put two together," Mr. Emmerson said.

Construction could start on the arena next April or May with completion in September 2009.
