York Regional Police are investigating claims money is being collected from Whitchurch-Stouffville merchants in the name of the community's youth hockey association.

At least two Stouffville businesses have been approached and at least one wrote a cheque to the "Stouffville Hockey Club". Receipts bear the address of a Main Street animal hospital and a postal code in Cobourg.

The motto "Minor sports builds major citizens" and a generic logo of a hockey player also appear. No phone number is listed.

A salesperson asks for \$350 to sponsor a house league team.

A merchant became suspicious of tactics used and contacted the Whitchurch-Stouffville Minor Hockey Association.

"It's not us," association president Mike Humphreys said. His organization contacted police Tuesday.
