### Team Red moves up in NASCAR

Stouffville-based Team Red/EHR race team has gained valuable ground in the NASCAR Canadian Tire Series overall point standings.

Jason Hathaway drove his Snap-on-Tools Dodge to a ninth-place finish in Sunday's GP3R100 race at the Grand Prix de Trois-Rivieres in Trois-Rivieres, Que.

Hathaway began the race in the 16th position in the 28-car field before completing the entire 41-laps on the 1.53-mile road course.

Hathaway was pleased with the result.

"We had a plan today to be patient and let the field shake out and then start making our way toward the front," he said.

"We set out the plan and it worked out great for us. We had a great result today for this team and our sponsors and we can't wait to get to the last four ovals of the year," he said.

Stouffville's Peter Gibbons drove his Mastercraft Chevrolet Monte Carlo to a 15th-place finish after starting the race in 12th place.

Kerry Micks of Mount Albert won the race.

Hathaway moved up into eighth place in the overall series standings with 1,075 points. Gibbons, fell to sixth with 1,157. Andrew Ranger leads the series with 1,292 points.

Four races remaining in the series, all on oval tracks. The next event will take place Sept. 1 at the Cayuga Speedway Park near Hamilton.

### Del Zotto, Canada fourth

Michael Del Zotto collected a pair of assists in a losing effort Saturday when Canada came out on the short end of a 5-4 decision to Russia in the bronze medal game of the Ivan Hlinka under-18 hockey tournament in Piešťany, Slovakia.

The 17-year-old Whitchurch-Stouffville resident, who just completed his first year with the Oshawa Generals of the Ontario Hockey League, helped set up two goals scored by his former Markham Waxers minor hockey teammate Cody Hodgson.

Canada entered the tournament having won 10 of the last 11 summer international tournaments.
