NOTICE TO RESIDENTS NEW WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM REVISION TO COLLECTION DAYS/AREAS

Please be advised that in addition to the changes in the Waste
 Collection Program (weekly blue box and green bin collection
 and bi-weekly garbage collection) some collection days/areas
 in Town will change. This change has been done to provide
 a balance in the collection routes. **Commencing the week of
 September 3rd** the following route changes will take place:

Collection Day Change – From Tuesday to Thursday

Collection Area includes:
 -Both sides of the Ninth Line – From Main Street south to
 the Markham Town boundary
 -Area bounded by the south side of Main Street, the east side
 of Hwy. 48, the Ninth Line and Markham Town Boundary.

Collection Day Change – From Tuesday to Wednesday

Collection Area includes:
 -Both sides of the Ninth Line from Main Street north to
 Bethesda Road
 -Area bounded by the north side of Main Street, the
 south side of Bethesda Road, the east side of Hwy. 48
 and York Regional Road 30.

Collection Day Change – From Thursday to Tuesday

Collection Area includes:
 -Area bounded by south side of Vandorf Road, the east
 side of Hwy. 404, the west side of Hwy. 48 and the north
 side of Bethesda Road.

NOTE: The following will remain a Tuesday collection day:
 Ratcliffe Road, Shalom Street, Fox Farm Gate, Sherrick Drive,
 Cedar Ridge Road and Wilderness Trail.

Collection Day Change – From Thursday to Friday

Collection Area includes:
 -Area bounded by the north side of Vandorf Road, the west
 side of Hwy. 48, the south side of Aurora Road and the west
 side of Kennedy Road.
 -Percy Wright Road, Elia Drive and Hill Country Drive

Collection Day Change – From Friday to Tuesday

Collection Area includes:
 -South side of Aurora Road from Hwy. 48 to Reg. Road 30
 -Island Lake Drive and Island Court
 -West side of Durham Regional Road 30 from Aurora
 Road south to and including Hillsdale Drive.

Green Bins Are Arriving!

Many Whitchurch-Stouffville residents have now received
 their Green Bins, delivery is expected to be completed shortly.
 Inside the Green Bin, you'll find a small kitchen container, a
 "what goes where" flyer, an information pamphlet, a new 16-
 month waste collection calendar and a handy fridge magnet.
 If you haven't received your Green Bin by September 4th or
 you're missing some of the contents, please contact the Town at
 905-640-1910, ext. 306.

We now have an information DVD available – great for com-
 munity service groups and kids clubs or interested individuals.
 Pick up a copy at our office!

Green Bin collection starts the week of September 10; please
 don't put your Green Bin out before the launch of the program.
 Check your new waste collection calendar to verify your pick-
 up date. Remember, Green Bin and Blue Box collection will be
 weekly starting the week of September 10th and garbage collec-
 tion will be bi-weekly. Yard waste collection will be increased
 to bi-weekly from April to November; collection dates can be
 found in your new calendar.

Some Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Where do I purchase additional kitchen containers and Green Bins?
 You may wish to wait until you've used the Green Bin before
 purchasing an extra one! Green Bins are designed to hold
 enough material for an average household of four and will be
 collected weekly. Additional containers and bins will be avail-
 able after September 4th at the Town offices, 37 Sandiford Drive,
 4th floor, at a cost of \$20 (incl taxes) for the Green Bin and \$5
 (incl taxes) for the smaller kitchen container.

2. Do I have to line the green bin?
 Yes. You may choose to line either the kitchen container or Green
 Bin (not both) with a plastic or biodegradable bag to protect the
 health and safety of the waste collector. Plastics are separated
 from organic materials at the processing facility.

3. I currently use a composter. Do I have to use the Green Bin as well?
 Continue to use your composter. The Green Bin can be used to
 collect materials not accepted by your composter, such as meat
 scraps and bones, pet waste and soiled paper products.

4. Where do I get more information?
 The information contained in your Green Bin will tell you all
 about how to use the program. If you still have questions, you
