THE BIN IS HERE!

AND IT'S GOING TO CHANGE THE WAY YOU THINK ABOUT GARBAGE.

Starting the week of September 10th, residents will enjoy an increased level of waste collection service with the introduction of weekly Green Bin collection, weekly Blue Box pickup and biweekly garbage collection. Yard waste collection will be increased to biweekly from April to the end of November.

Most residents have now received their Green Bins. Inside the bin, you'll find a small kitchen container, a "what goes where" flyer, an information pamphlet, a new 16-month waste collection calendar and a handy fridge magnet. If you haven't received your Green Bin or if you're missing some of the contents, please contact the Town at 905-640-1910 ext. 306 or 905-895-5299 ext 306.

It's time to start saving your food scraps, soiled paper products, pet waste, etc. Next week you'll be ready to place your Green Bin at the curb. Please note that some collection days/areas have changed to provide a balance in the entire waste collection schedule; check your new collection calendar to verify your collection day.

New Collection Contractor

Commencing September 4th your new collection contractor is Turtle Island Recycling Corporation. For collection inquiries, call 1-866-421-5625.

Large Article Collection has changed. Large metal items such as appliances, barbecues (no tanks), furnaces, metal bath tubs, bicycles, etc are *picked up on a pre-arranged basis* on Thursdays of the garbage collection week; call **1-866-421-5625 to arrange for collection**. **Construction and demolition materials** (drywall, wood, concrete, bricks, cinder blocks, etc) are *not accepted*. These materials may be taken to the York Region Transfer Station at 23068 Warden Ave. Please refer to Page 3 of your new collection calendar for details. **Non-metal items** such as furniture, mattresses, plastic lawn furniture, carpeting (max 100 lbs) may be placed curbside on your regular garbage collection day; you are no longer required to call in advance for pickup of these items. Please refer to Page 17 of your new collection calendar for details.
