It's no surprise the Internet is playing an increasingly important role in election campaigns.

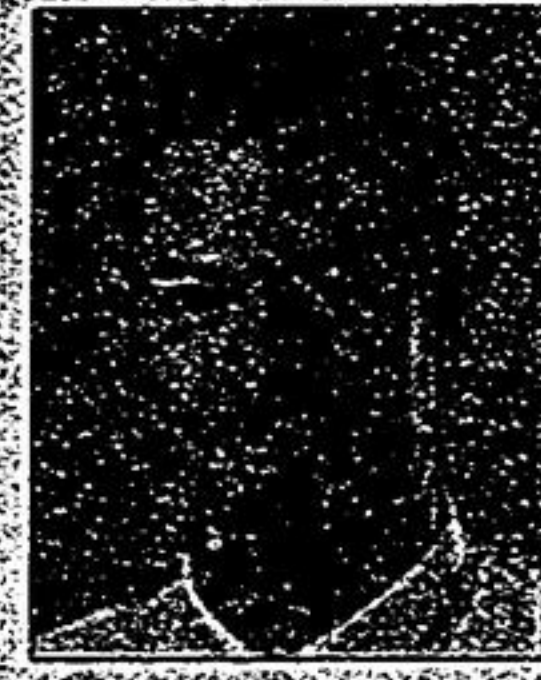
The breadth of the information it offers is rivalled only by the scale of its reach.
