

Sundial second in Canada

Stouffville will join the tradition of using church sundials to mark time tomorrow.

The vertical sundial that local physician Don Petrie is placing on the south wall of Christ Church Anglican will be the second such sundial in Canada.

The other is on the wall of Christ Church Anglican in Victoria, B.C.

The tradition of placing sundials on the walls of Anglican and Roman Catholic churches dates back hundreds of years. The sundial let parishioners know when it was time to attend mass and vespers and keep track of time before the invention of clocks.

They are extremely accurate when

they are properly mounted.

The tradition is well-established in Europe and other countries.

Westminster Abbey and its sister church, St. Margaret's in London, each have a couple of dials on their walls.

Dr. Petrie, who has had an interest in sundials for almost 20 years, recently gave a talk to the North American Sundial Society in Washington, D.C., about the sundial that will be installed in Stouffville.

The sundial will be unveiled at tomorrow at 11 a.m.

The church is at 254 Sunset Blvd., next to Orchard Park Public School
