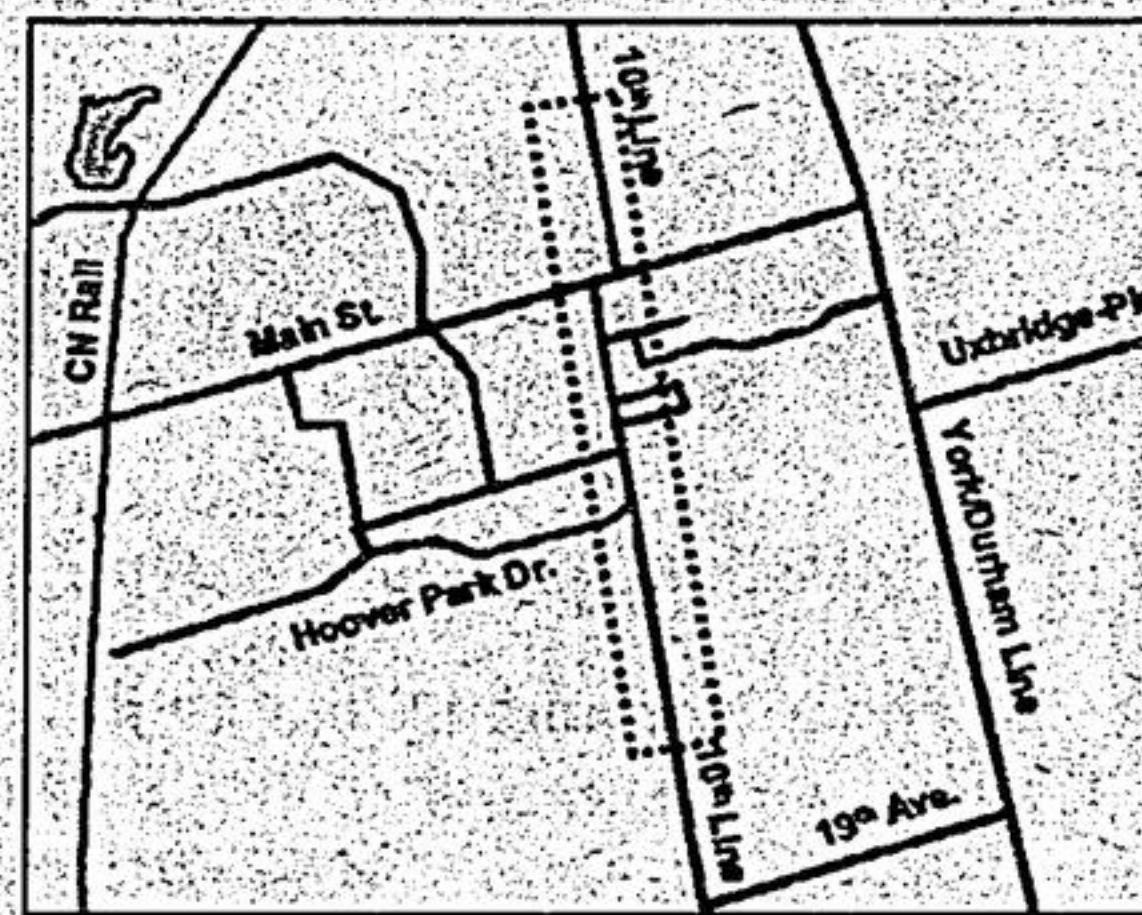

TENTH LINE WIDENING AND RECONSTRUCTION

Class Environmental Assessment Study

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville is undertaking a Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the widening and reconstruction of Tenth Line. The study area includes a 3 km section of Tenth Line, from the southern boundary of the Town to Forsyth Farm Road, north of Main Street.

This notice announces the first Public Information Centre (PIC) for this project. This study will define the problem/opportunities, identify and evaluate alternative solutions, and determine a preferred design for Tenth Line in consultation with the Town, regulatory agencies, stakeholder groups, and the general public. The study is being conducted in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MEA, June 2000), which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

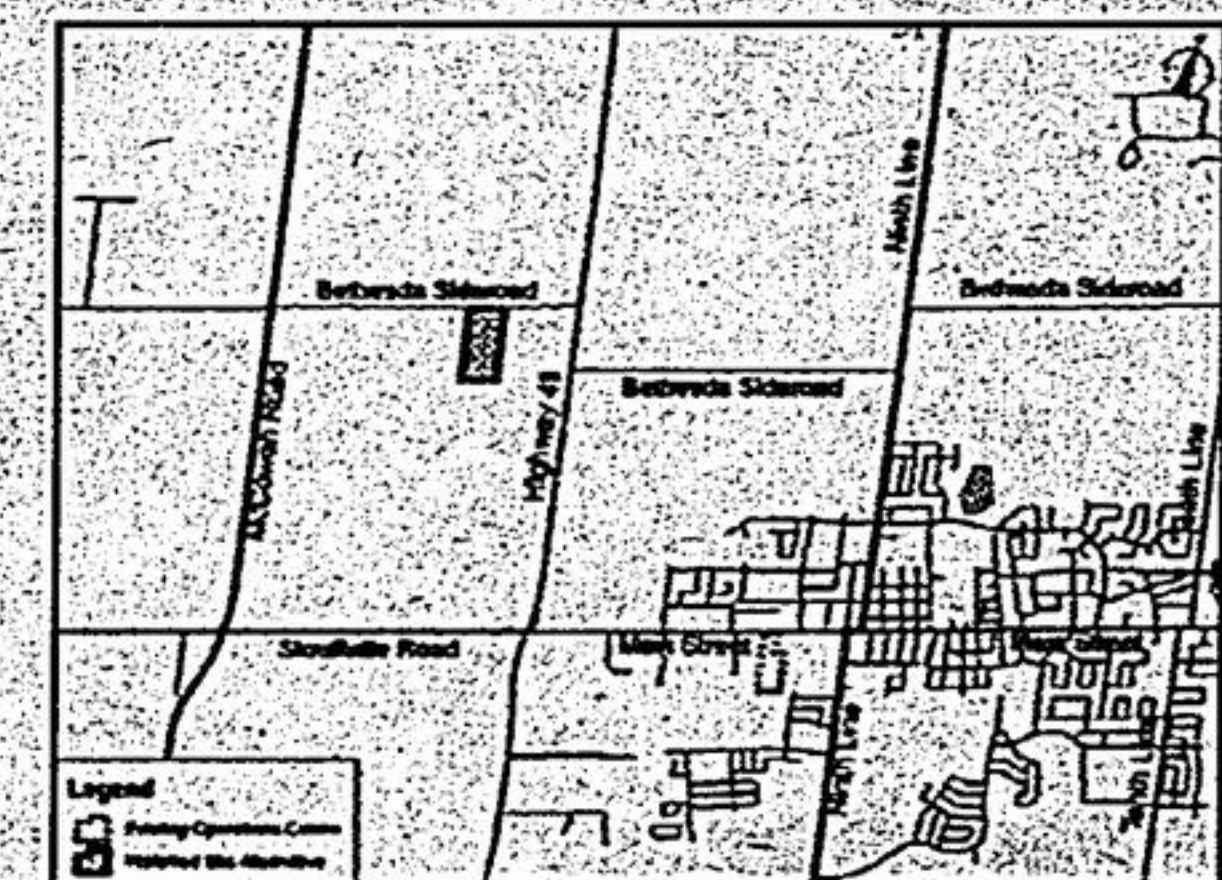

Class Environmental Assessment for a New Operations Centre

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville is undertaking a Class Environmental Assessment for a new Operations Centre. This study is being conducted as a Schedule "C" Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, which is an approved process under the Environmental Assessment Act.

This Public Information Centre (PIC) will provide the public with an opportunity to review the detailed assessment of the alternative site locations and the evaluation which leads to the Technically Preferred Site. Public and agency comments obtained at the PIC or by correspondence will be included as part of the final evaluation to identify the Recommended Site. Following the PIC, an Environmental Study Report (ESR) will be completed in November 2007 and made available for public review for a thirty (30) day period.

WASTE COLLECTION

Yard Waste Collection

Yard Waste is now collected on Mondays, every second week from April to November. Due to the Statutory holiday on Monday October 8th, the next yard waste collection day will be **SATURDAY October 13th**. Please make sure yard waste is placed in paper yard waste bags or any rigid open top container that has handles. Please note that tree branches must be tied in bundles and should be no larger than 30 cm (12") in diameter and no longer than 1.12 m (4') in length. Plastic bags will not be accepted. Refer to page 11 of your collection calendar for more details.

Garbage Collection

Residents are reminded that garbage is now collected bi-weekly and there is a maximum three-bag limit per household. Additional bags will only be collected provided a "Garbage Bag Tag" is affixed to each bag. Please refer to page 6 of your collection calendar for locations where these tags can be purchased.

Please have garbage, green bins, blue boxes and yard waste to the curb by 7:00 am on your collection day.
