## PUBLIC NOTICE

York Region is undertaking a review of the Environmental Study Report (ESR) for the Ninth Line of Stouffville from Highway 407 to Main Street.

Ninth Line is a regional road that provides for major traffic flow from Musselman's Lake and Stouffville to and from Markham and Toronto. Planned growth in Stouffville will result in high traffic volumes and excessive delays in this corridor, warranting a review of the Region's planned roadway improvements for the Ninth Line. The jog elimination at Main Street will also be re-evaluated in this study.

To receive public input for this project, York Region will be hosting a Public Consultation Centre on October 30, 2007 at Latham Hall, 8 Park Drive, Stouffville. Please see full notice on page 22.
