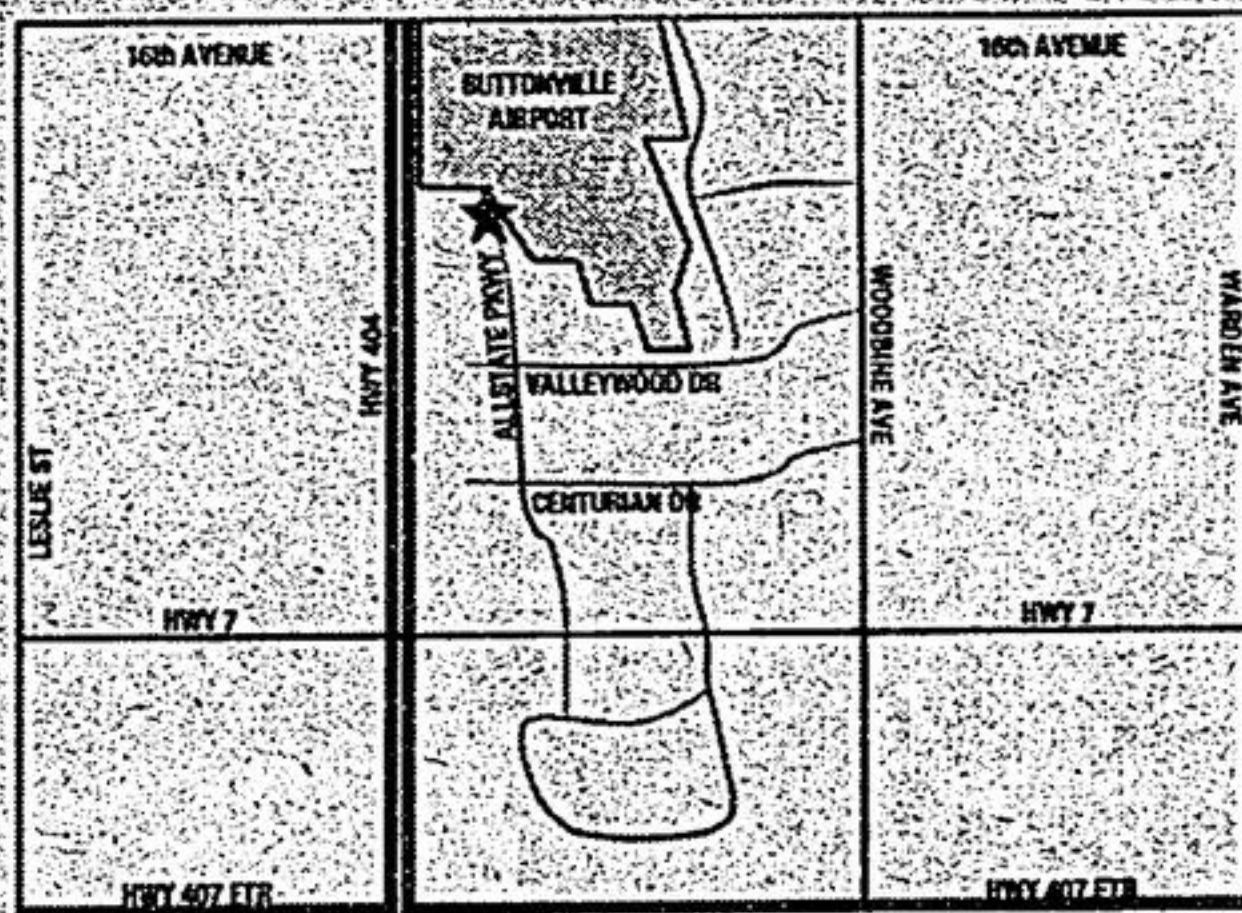

So said.

That process can only start after the environmental study report is finalized.

Finalizing the design concept won't happen until talks with property owners and the legion are done, Mr. So said.

A public information meeting on the Ninth Line jog was held Oct. 30. About 70 people attended.

One of them was David

Hoover, owner of Earl Hoover's Machine and Welding Ltd. on Main Street at Fairview Avenue. He wasn't invited to the meeting by the town, he said, and has not been contacted by regional or town staff.

After listening to the information presented at the meeting, he believes it is "pretty much a given" that his shop will be affected. In operation since 1951, it is one of Stouffville's oldest businesses.

Taking out the jog will affect a lot of people, Mr. Hoover said.

However, he thinks it would be better if a bypass was put around the community to ease traffic congestion.

BYPASS PREFERRED

The jog elimination should have been done in the early 1950s, Mr. Hoover said, when there were just fields north of Main Street.

Since acquisition of properties could start in four years, Mr. Pattenden wants to be proactive and meet with town officials soon.

The legion hall and the property it sits on are owned by the Royal Canadian Legion's Ontario Command and it would become involved if there was to be a purchase or expropriation.

If the current legion hall was displaced, members would like another location in Stouffville that is accessible to veterans in scooters and easy to walk to, said Mr. Pattenden.

"It seems to be a long

process, Mr. Pattenden said. "If we could start something now, it would help us out in the long run."

Mayor Wayne Emmerson spoke to legion members in the spring, Mr. Pattenden said.

In an interview with The Stouffville Sun-Tribune, Mr. Emmerson said he wants to have another meeting with council members present and is open to residents' concerns.

Before any plans are implemented, they would have to be approved by regional and town council.

"My mandate was to eliminate these stoplights on Main Street and the jog elimination," Mr. Emmerson said. "The traffic is getting worse instead of better."

The region has earmarked 2014 as the date for construction of the jog elimination.

That's too long for the mayor.

"I don't think we are waiting seven years to have that jog elimination done," Mr. Emmerson said.
