

Johnston, O'Neill serve up franchise's first shootout win

Like the Toronto Maple Leafs, the Stouffville Spirit has been pondering its shootout strategy.

If worked Thursday at the Stouffville Arena.

Playing host to the Couchiching Terriers, the Spirit posted its first shootout win of the Provincial Jr. A Hockey League season in three attempts, 3-2. This is the first year for the shootout in Jr. A.

After Spirit goalkeeper Trevor O'Neill successfully thwarted the first four Terriers shooters, Spirit captain Randy Johnston deposited the game-winning marker, the only goal of the shootout.

"We hadn't been too fortunate in shootouts this year," D'Ammizio said.

Making the victory even more satisfying was the character the club displayed in overcoming a 2-0 deficit through 40 minutes.

A goal by Mark Sullivan just after the Spirit had killed off a two-man disadvantage ignited the comeback that was followed by a power-play goal from James McIntosh.

"Sullivan's goal gave us life," D'Ammizio said. "But overall we got great leadership from our veteran guys including Randy Johnston."

As well, D'Ammizio was quick to praise the work of O'Neill.

"He played well the entire game and made some great saves in the shootout," D'Ammizio said.

TRADEWINDS BLOW

Now 14-8-3 on the season and occupying fifth place in the North Conference, the Spirit outshot the Terriers, who remain in third place with an 18-7-2 mark, 45-26.

With today being the league deadline for clubs to get down to 25 player cards, the Spirit had yet to make any moves as of early Friday morning.

Spirit general manager Tom Milne has been working the telephone lines in recent days in an attempt to move disgruntled forwards Donivan Munro and Mike Foy. Both have left the team and demanded to be traded.

The Spirit resumes league play today when it hosts the Newmarket Hurricanes at 7:30 p.m.
