Signing dance troupe, animals in weekend production

A sign-language interpretive dance troupe is part of Springvale Baptist Church's Christmas drama, *The Treasure*, starting tomorrow night.

All monies raised go to the 2008 Weekend to End Breast Cancer in Toronto through Whitchurch-Stouffville's One Horse Farm team.

The team, which has

raised \$38,000 during the last two years, hopes to collect at least \$20,000 before the September walk.

"With each bulb lit, with each little angel given flight, the tree in support of vital breast cancer research and care by the Princess Margaret Hospital Foundation shines a little brighter," captain Carin Bacher said.

Each donation will receive a tax receipt.

Tellers at TD Canada Trust will accept donations.

Bulbs lit in honor of a survivor or in memory of a loved one are a different shade of pink.


