Verse 16 .- "And he came to Nazareth, where he had been-brought up." It is always a difficult ordeal for a young man to preach his first sermon in his home church. The Nazarenes were particularly slow to accept one of their own young men, brought up to carpentry, as a teacher.

Verse 17.—"The book of the prophet Esaias." The rolls were kept in a wooden box, called the ark, which was hidden from view by curtains. The Chazzan would hand the roll to Jesus in the pulpit. Whether the Lord Jesus Christ read the set portion for the day, or chose His own passage, is difficult to determine. At any rate, it was a notable Messianic portion, Isaiah 61:1, 2.
