### Owners Get 1920 Prices if Shipped Steers Die, Hurt

If a steer dies or is injured while being shipped by rail, its owner is entitled to claim the amount a similar animal was worth in 1920.

Shippers want the railways to pay the present market value of livestock, which they say is three or four times as much as when the railway contracts were drawn up 31 years ago.

The Toronto Livestock Exchange asked for a revision at a meeting last week with R. K. Watson, chairman of the Canadian Freight Association, and railway officials. Supporting the Toronto group were members of the Montreal and Winnipeg livestock exchanges.

The shippers also asked that the railways provide slatted cars in winter to prevent chilling draughts on the animals.


