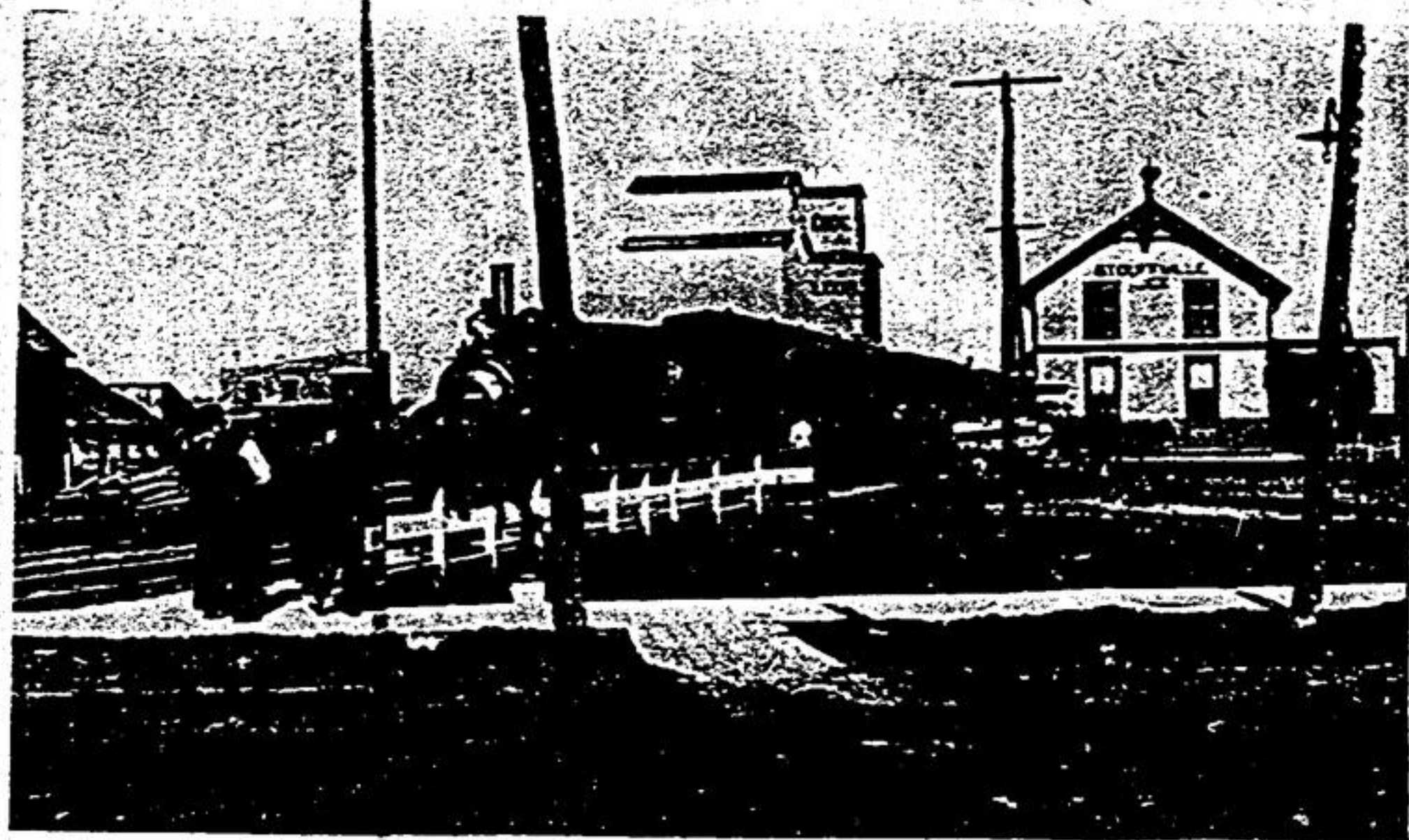


Village of Stouffville Scenes today and yesterday



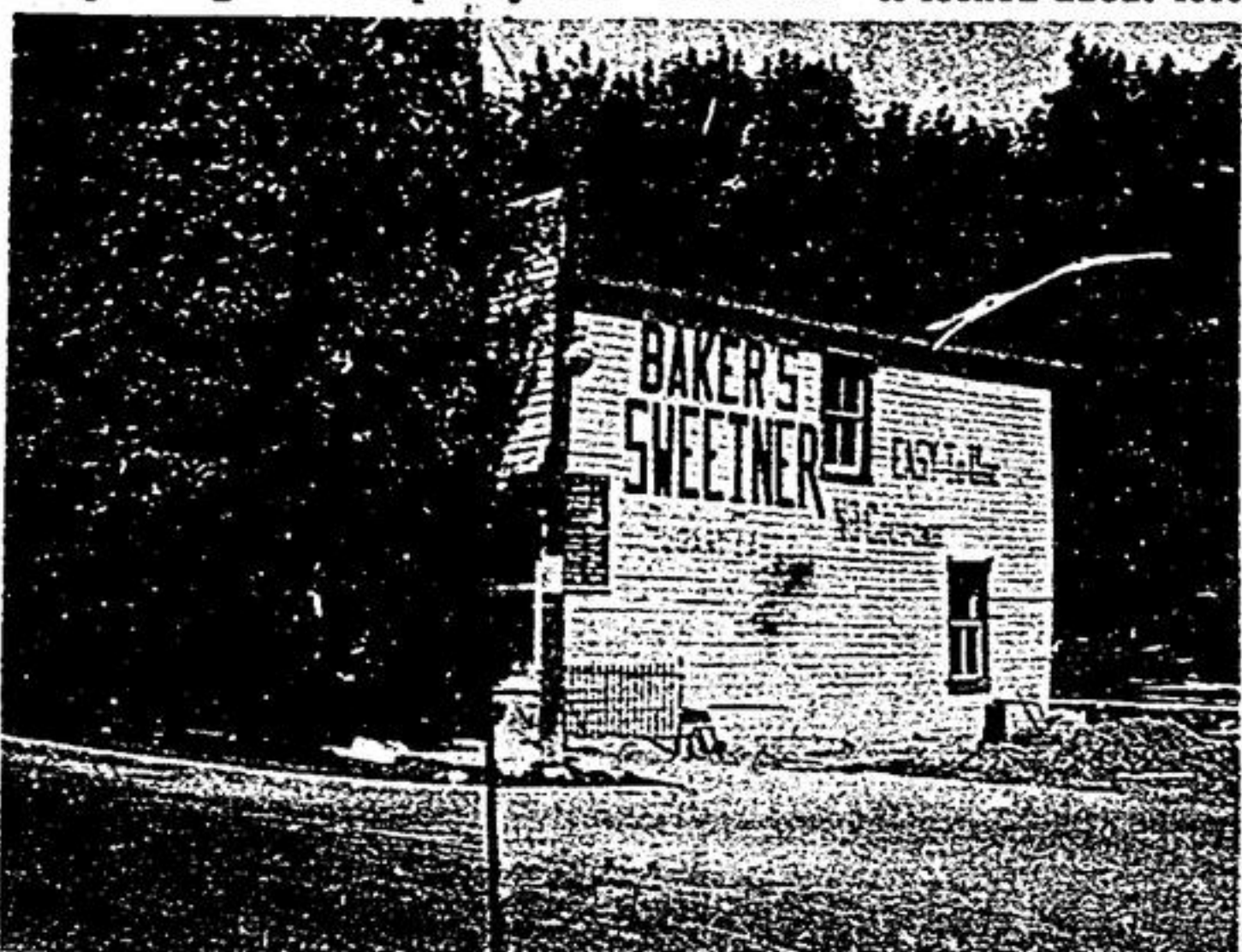

Once a village, now a town Stouffville has seen many changes in the past years. One such location is the railroad station, pictured here as it looked about 1910.



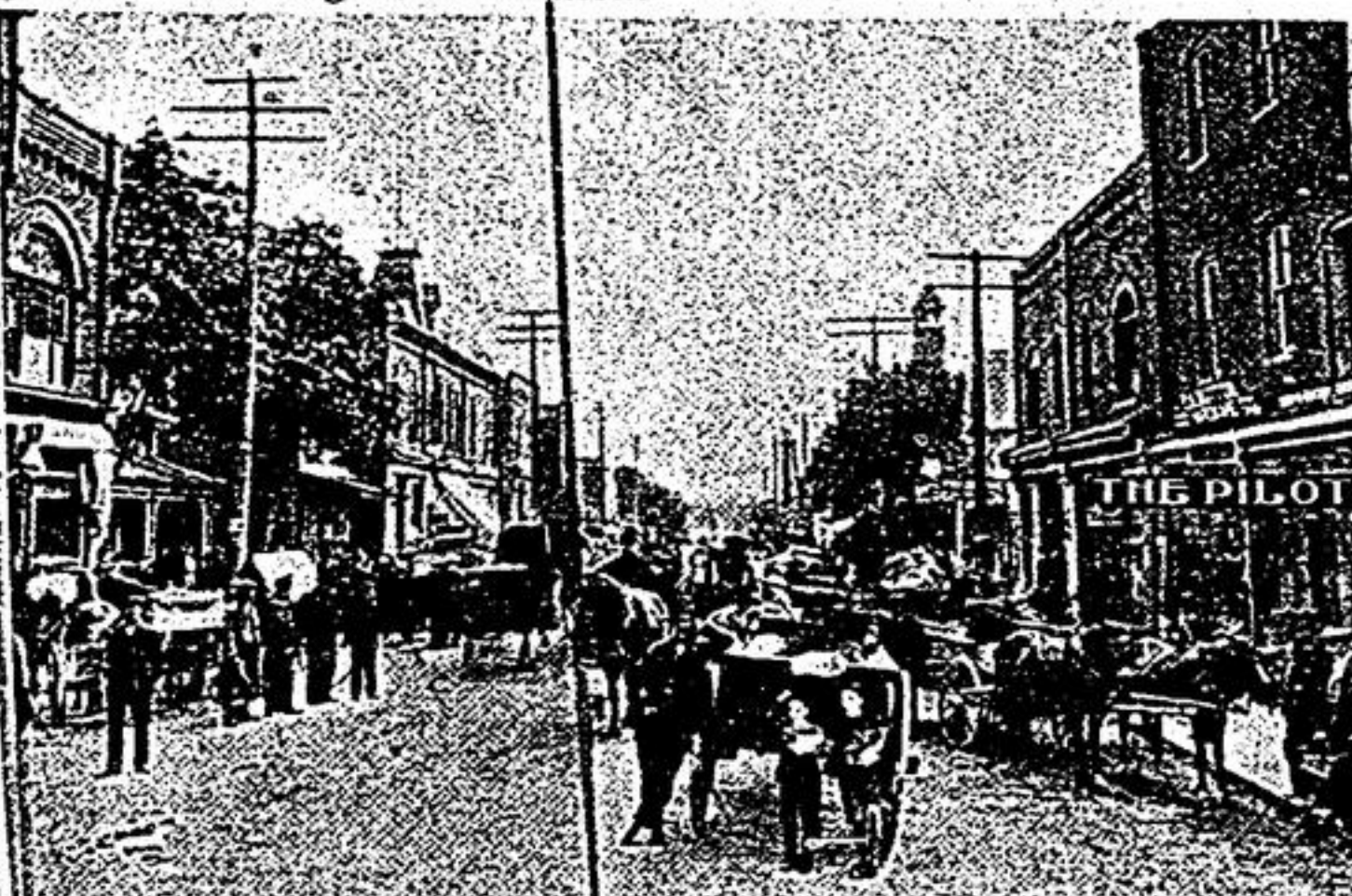
This is the public school on Main Street East, not Summitview, but the one before that. The late James Hand was the principal there many years.

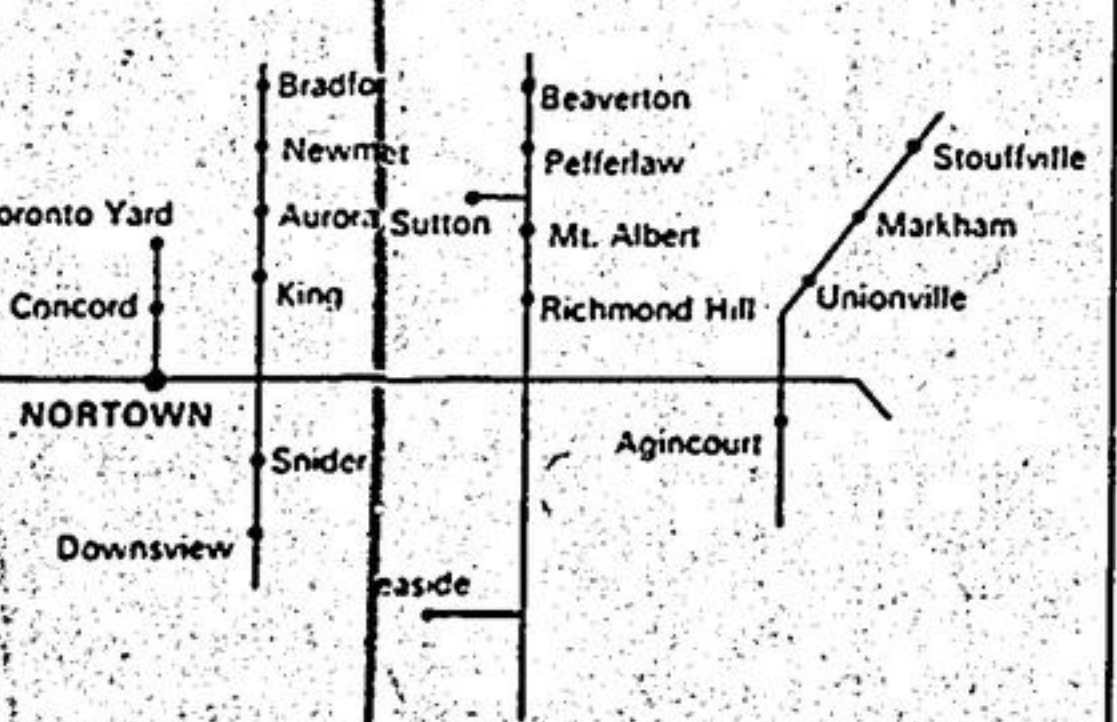
