In 1965, he moved to St. Lambert Baptist Church and in May 1969 was received into the United Church of Canada and has since served at Richmond Hill. ## Wed in Lindsay

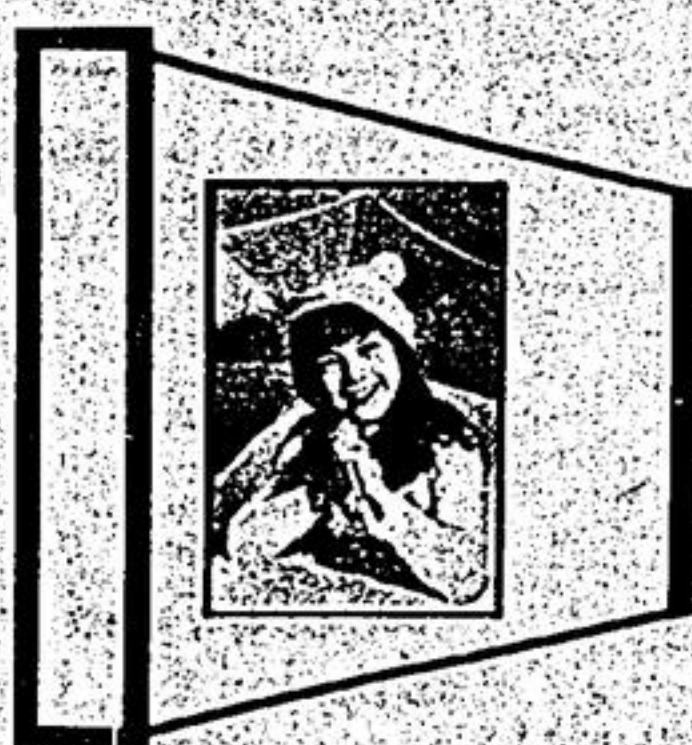
