Twp. of Pickering

Council considers free-call service

PICKERING TWP. - Bell Canada has advised Pickering Township Council that a one-way toll-free system for the 942 exchange in the township and Ajax to Toronto, Scarborough and West Hill by 1973 would cost \$27,000. For a resident's phone the rate would be \$11.70 per month; for an individual business phone, \$27.65 and for an individual trunk line, \$41.45.

The capital cost of a two-way service to Toronto would cost \$2,100,000 and could be available by 1975.

As it stands now, in Pickering Township residents with the 942 exchange can call Oshawa and Whitby toll free, but cannot call their closer neighbors in the Claremont area, or north-west Pickering, without a toll charge. On the 839 exchange, in the urban area, residents can call Toronto without charge.

It's a long distance charge for residents in the northern part of the township to call their own municipal offices, which have the 942 exchange. On the 942 exchange, the adjacent Markham area can be reached toll free, but those on the 942 exchange, even though they are closer to Markham in some parts, are not toll free.

Claremont area residents cannot call either Oshawa or Toronto without a long distance charge.

Reeve - \$2,200

GOODWOOD Uxbridge Twp. Council members have granted themselves a pay raise, but their remuneration still falls for short of wages received in some adjoining municipalities.

Reeve Bob Nesbitt will receive \$2,200 in 1971, up from \$1,500. Deputy Reeve Don Jackson wins a \$300 increase, up from \$1,200 to \$1,500.

Councillors will receive \$18.00 for each meeting attended with one third of the total classed as mileage.

Planning Board members will be paid \$15 per meetings attended to a maximum of \$300 for the year. The secretary will receive \$250.

Opposed to the resolution on a recorded vote were reeve Nesbitt and deputy-reeve Jackson.

Notice to Property Owners to Destroy Weeds

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all persons in possession of land in accordance with the Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 427, Sections 8, 13 and 19, that unless the noxious weeds or weed seeds growing on their lands within the Town of Markham are destroyed by Tuesday, June 8th, 1971, and throughout the season as often as it is necessary to prevent the ripening of their seeds and dispersal of their pollens, the Council of the Town of Markham has appointed W. Shearn, Weed Inspector, to cause said weeds or weed seeds to be destroyed in such a manner as he may deem proper, and that the expenses incurred by the said Weed Inspector in the discharge of his duties shall be placed on the Collector's Roll of the Municipality against the respective lands concerned and that such amounts shall be collected in the same manner as taxes.

The co-operation of all persons concerned is earnestly solicited.
