



STOUFFVILLE Whitchurch - Stouffville Planning Committee has approved in principle, the estate residential development on conc. 9, north of Musselman's Lake. A resolution to this effect will be sent to York Regional Council.

The action followed a meeting, June 29, between the Committee and Robert Forfar, the applicant. Mr. R. Alam, of the Department of Municipal Affairs, also

attended. Mr. Alam revealed that the Department had approved plans for six lots, but was unwilling to approve any more unless the Official Plan was amended. A revision in zoning is now required before work

can begin. Several councillors expressed dissatisfaction at the length of time taken over this matter. It was pointed out that the project was first conceived in 1946.




