Twp. of Pickering

To hire administrative officer

PICKERING TWP. - Pickering Township Council is to hire a chief administrative officer responsible to the council with jurisdiction over all departments.

Advertising for this new \$20,000 to \$25,000 executive has already begun. The township's management consultants, Stevenson and Kellogg Limited,

have been retained to assist council in the selection of the right individual as well as assisting the municipality in the administrative restructuring. It is hoped that the position will be filled by late summer.

Deputy Reeve George Ashe read in his prepared news release: "In creating this new position the council recognizes that there is a need to coordinate the day to day operations of the municipality, and to bring together into a team effort the various departmental activities so that the municipal function can be put into high gear to better accommodate

and expedite the development explosion which is on our doorstep".

A simple majority vote of council will hire or release the employee. Councillor Vic Rudik said he felt the position was of such importance it would attract the best possible candidates. All municipal operations will be directed by the administrator. He will implement council's policies.

The vote was unanimous.

"This is beyond our boundaries", observed Reeve Bob Nesbitt. The letter was received and tabled.

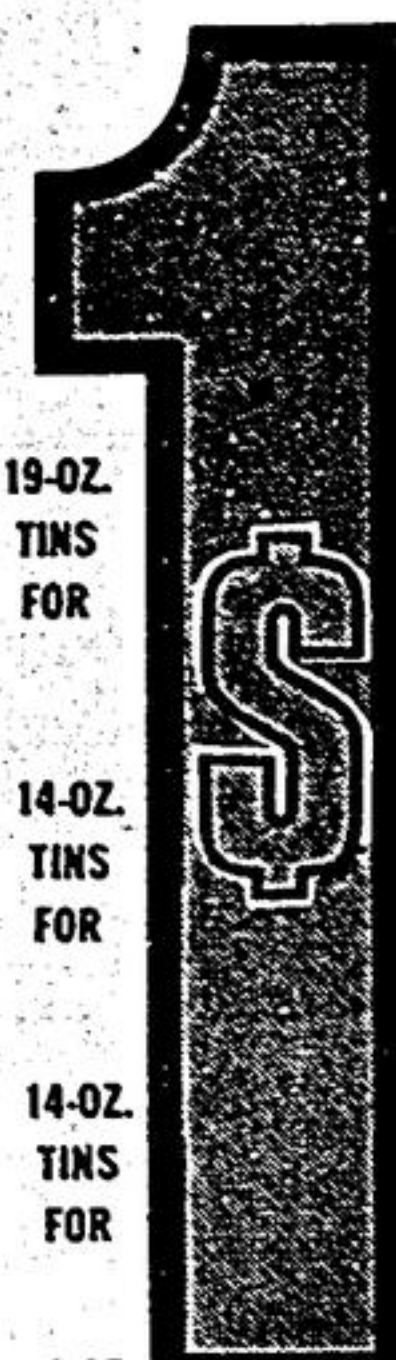
