## Floral designs

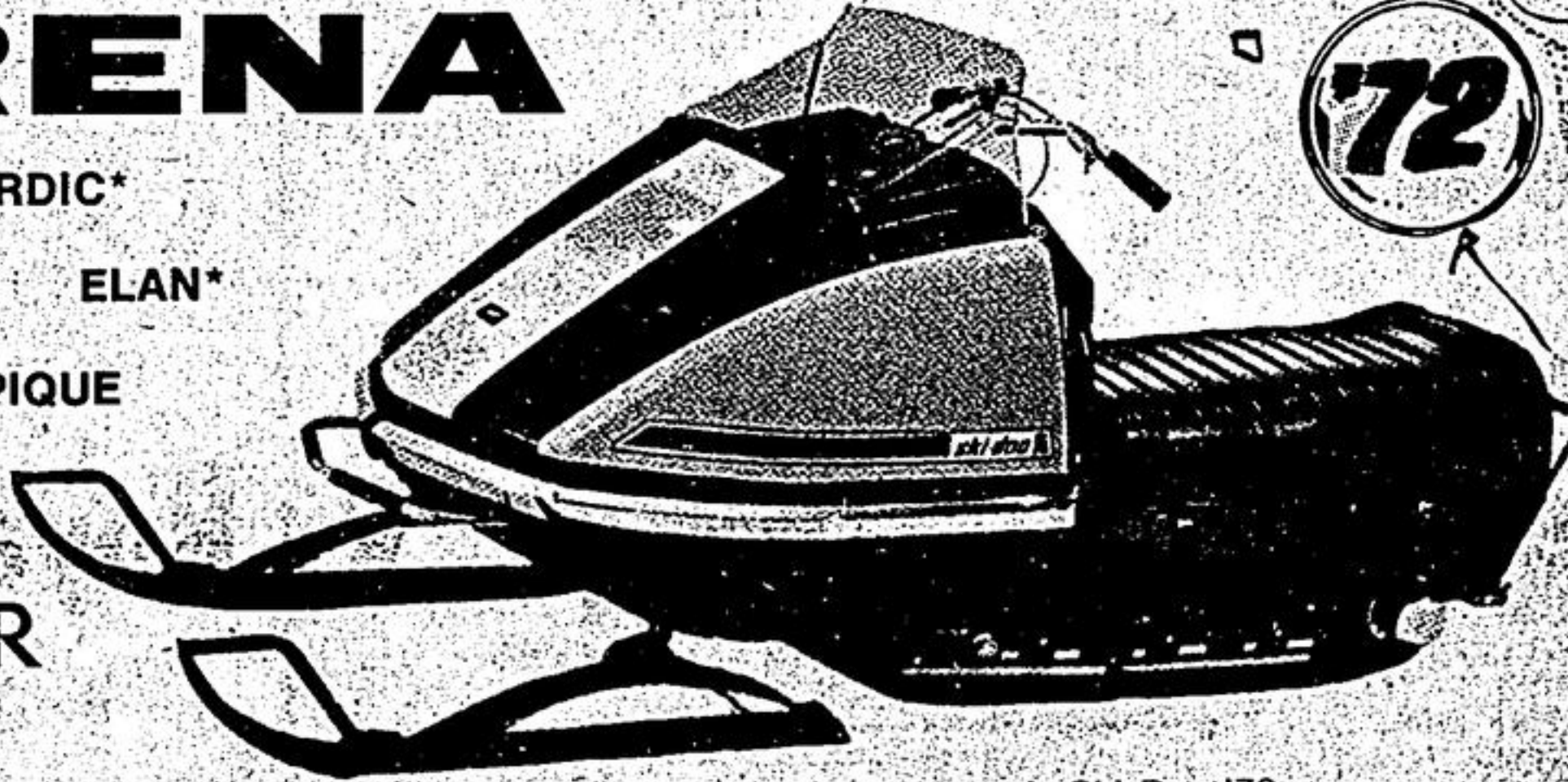
