



THE MAN AND THE PROGRAM

ENVIRONMENT

Bob Lewis led one thousand people in their fight against the potential pollution of the Stouffville water supply. And won! The Premier has said his government has "laid down the law" on pollution. But the average fine for water pollution over the past two years has been only \$353. Domtar was fined \$1000. Domtar's profits after taxes were \$17,000,000. In the same period the Conservative government gave Domtar \$900,000 in loans.

MEDICARE

Under the Conservatives, health-care in Ontario costs a family \$264. a year. The NDP plan in Saskatchewan costs a comparable family \$72. a year. The NDP Ontario health-care plan will save you 61% on premiums.

RAPID TRANSIT

The NDP are committed to immediate action.

AUTO INSURANCE

All three candidates favour a GO train and extended rapid transit but the Conservatives have had 28 years to turn promises into results.

More house-building starts, pollution control, municipal works projects and services to people... these are only some areas in which employment opportunities can be created in "our" Ontario.

PAYING THE BILL

The NDP has made several commitments to the people of Ontario. We've promised to lower the sales tax by 1% and to transfer much of the cost of education to the province, thus reducing local property taxes. This will cost money. But it will come from new tax fields which have almost totally escaped their fair share of responsibility. When the entire mining industry in Ontario paid \$34 million in taxes, one company alone made a profit of more than \$200 million after taxes. An NDP government will end the corporate tax writeoff, and apply the major portion (\$75 million) to the immediate creation of jobs.

A capital gains tax, in keeping with the principles of the Carter Commission proposals, will further expand the tax base.

The NDP stand on taxation is based upon the belief that everyone should pay his fair share... no more... but certainly no less!

CAMPAIN COSTS

Bob Lewis' campaign cost is \$5200. Every cent is coming from voluntary donations from individuals in York North. All contributions are public.

His opponents are obviously spending much more. They refuse to say how much or disclose their sources.
