**'Dragging his feet'**

## Submit site plan or else — Council

**PICKERING TWP.** The controversial matter of a used machinery outlet on Brock Road at the 7th concession has reared its head again.

Pickering Township Council has given Howard Burton, owner of the operation, 60 days to submit his site plan, else the resolution that approved a change in zoning subject to receipt of the site plan, will be ruled null and void.

It was about a year ago that, after years of debate on the peculiar situation of this business, planning board and council passed the resolution to approve, pending the receipt of the site plan.

There is an outstanding appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board, according to Planning Director John Faulkner, who said about Mr. Burton: "He's been dragging his feet every way he can."

Faulkner said that the board and council were in a state of limbo, with an operation going on which is improper, and the municipality is taking no action to have it cease.

Councillor Vic Rudik said that the thing was so complicated that he could scarcely remember what had transpired. He said that council's decision was based on sufficient evidence to recognize that there was an existing operation of a similar nature in the area.

Councillor Jean McPherson said that Burton was waiting to hear from the O.M.B., and she didn't know whether he knows about the site plan and feels it too big a chance to take.

Deputy Reeve George Ashe recalled that when the operation was ap-

TAKE NOTICE THAT:

- The Council of The Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge intends to undertake as a local improvement the opening and improving of those streets forming part of The Glen Acres Subdivision in the Township of Uxbridge as more particularly set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and the construction thereon of a granular base and low cost bituminous pavement. The Corporation intends to specially assess a part of the cost of the work on the east-west streets on the land abutting directly thereon and a part of the cost of the work on the north-south streets on the said land abutting directly on the east-west streets as immediately benefited by the work on the north-south streets.
- The estimated cost of the work is \$100,000.00 of which \$12,748.37 is to be paid by The Corporation. The estimated cost per foot frontage is \$6.74. The special assessment is to be paid in ten (10) equal annual instalments and the estimated annual rate per foot frontage is \$1.05.
- Application will be made by The Corporation to the Ontario Municipal Board for its approval of the undertaking of the work and since this Notice is being mailed and published pursuant to the provisions of Section 8(4) of The Local Improvement Act, R.S.O. 1970, C.255, any owner of property may within twenty-one (21) days after the publication or mailing of the said Notice, whichever is later, file with the Clerk of The Corporation at its offices in Goodwood in the Township of Uxbridge his objection to the work being undertaken.
- The Board may approve of the work being undertaken, but before doing so it may appoint a time and place when any objections to the work will be considered.
