Wellwater is wasted

STOUFFVILLE - Wells which supply more water than is needed are a source of irritation for Councillor Gordon Ratcliff. At a Council meeting, Jan. 25, Mr. Ratcliff said some people are drilling wells much larger than they need. The result is a high runoff.

"This is a direct waste", charged Councillor Ratcliff. "I think we should conserve all the water possible".

He asked how much control the municipality could exert in this respect. Mayor Ken Laushway was doubtful that the Town could do much, and criticized provincial regulations as "not strong enough".

Councillor Merlyn Baker suggested the Ontario Water Resources Commission have some power in this matter. It was agreed that the Legislative Committee should make enquiries and report back.
