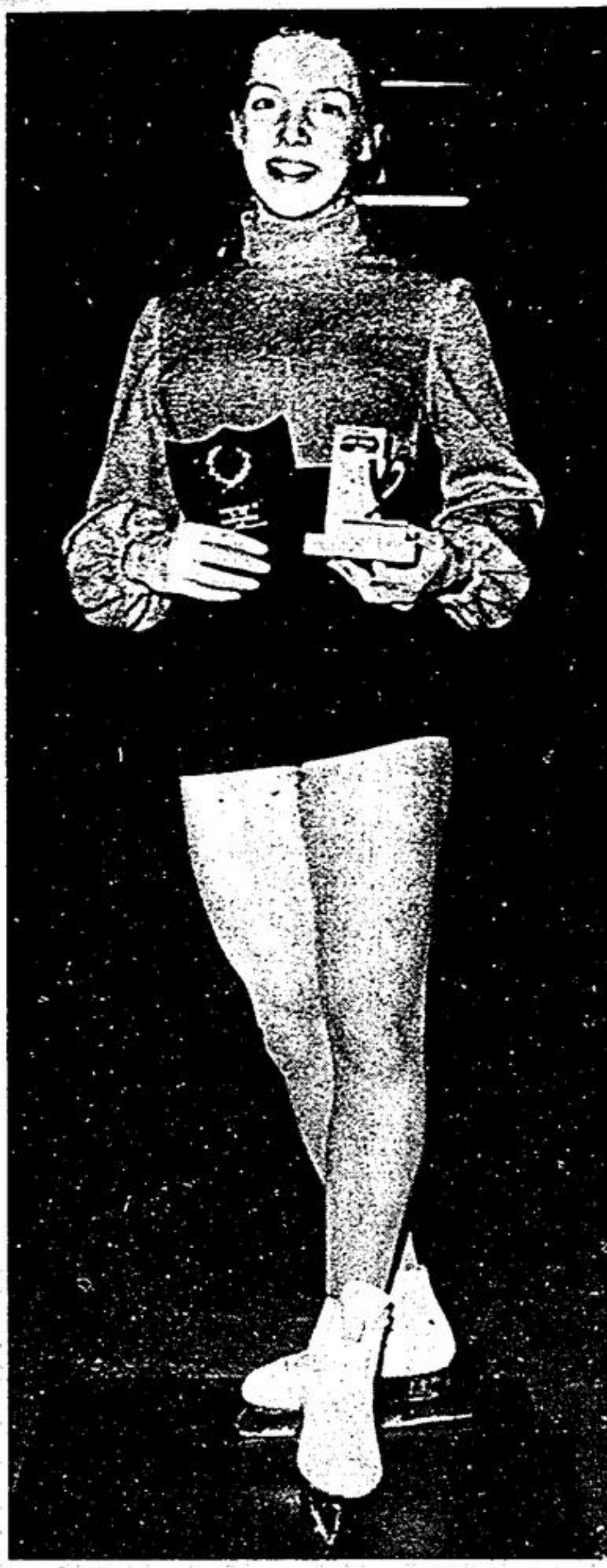
A speedy recovery is wished for Mrs. Fred Harris following surgery in the Uxbridge Cottage Hospital.
