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## Rejection repeated

BALLANTRAE - Council has refused to change its position on a further extension of the present V.L.A. subdivision at Ballantrae.

A letter from Harry Raymond, Felray's solicitor, was considered at the meeting, Feb. 22. Mr. Raymond said his client objects to the Agricultural zoning presently on part of the land in the Ballantrae area. He asked that the property be rezoned, and gave several reasons, including: the fact that Township officials were aware an application to ex-

tend the subdivision would be made; the second phase does not conflict with the Toronto-Centred Region Plan; there is an adequate supply of water; and present zoning is not in accordance with the Official Plan.

Council members appeared unimpressed. Mayor Ken Laushway observed the matter has been discussed at several meetings, and a "final decision" was taken in a resolution, Feb. 8. Other councillors declined to comment, and the letter was filed.

**The Expropriations Act**  
**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO EXPROPRIATE LAND**

IN THE MATTER of an application by the Minister of Transportation and Communications for approval to expropriate lands in the Township of Whitechurch-Stouffville, in the Regional Municipality of York, in the Province of Ontario for the purpose of acquiring sufficient land for the widening and reconstruction of Highway Number 48.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described in the schedule hereto.

Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing.

(a) in the case of a registered owner, service personally or by registered mail within thirty days after he is served with the notice, or, when he is served by publication, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice;

(b) in the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice.

THE APPROVING AUTHORITY IS:  
Minister of Transportation and Communications, Parliament Buildings, Toronto 5, Ontario.

Minister of Transportation and Communications' W. G. Wigle, Director, Right of Way Branch.

NOTES:

- The Expropriations Act, provides that, (a) where an inquiry is requested, it shall be conducted by an inquiry officer appointed by the Minister of Justice and Attorney General;
- the inquiry officer, (i) shall give every party to the inquiry an opportunity to present evidence and argument and to examine and cross-examine witnesses, either personally or by his counsel or agent, and (ii) may recommend to the approving authority that a party to the inquiry be paid a fixed amount for his costs of the inquiry not to exceed \$200 and the approving authority may in its discretion order the expropriating authority to pay such costs forthwith.
- "owner" and "registered owner" are defined in the Act as follows: "owner" includes a mortgagee, tenant, execution creditor, a person entitled to a limited estate or interest in land, a committee of the estate of a mentally incompetent person or of a person incapable of managing his affairs, and a guardian executor, administrator or trustee in whom land is vested; "registered owner" means an owner of land whose interest in the land is defined and whose name is specified in an instrument in the proper registry, land titles or sheriff's office, and includes a person shown as a tenant of land on the last revised assessment roll;
- The expropriating authority, each owner who notifies the approving authority that he desires a hearing in respect of the lands intended to be expropriated and any owner added as a party, by the inquiry officer are parties to the inquiry.
