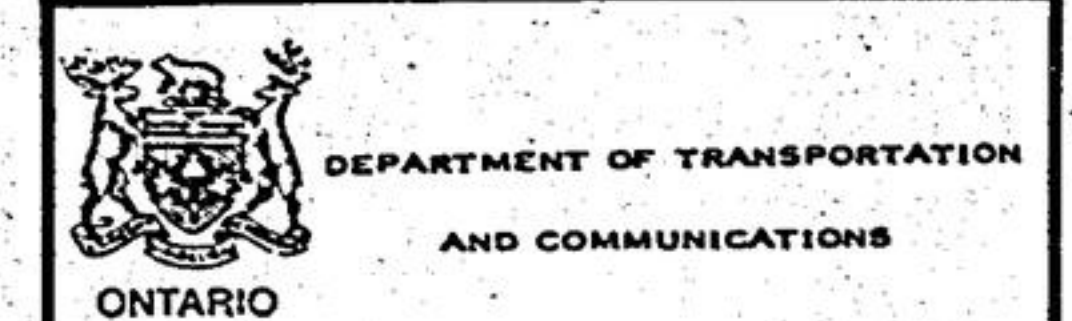
No souvenir stands
