**Urge 'freeze' exemptions**

STOUFFVILLE - Several area residents have received sympathetic consideration to their requests for exemption from the Minister's order which froze thousands of acres in Whitechurch - Stouffville.

At a meeting March 28, Council approved a request from Franklin Lowe, who wishes to build on a 7-acre lot fronting on Cherry Street, near Vivian. The Minister's order provides a 25-acre minimum for building lots, but Mr. Lowe's plans are already well advanced.

The Minister has asked municipalities to comment on such applications, and Council members were favorably inclined to Mr. Lowe's application. Plans by Mr. and Mrs. John Griffin, on the Vivian Sideroad, and Ivan McLaughlin in the 8th Concession, were also recommended for approval.

Only one application, made by Felray Investments, was the subject of any doubts. Council recommended lifting the freeze on those Felray lots included in Phase I development, but refused to advise the same action for
