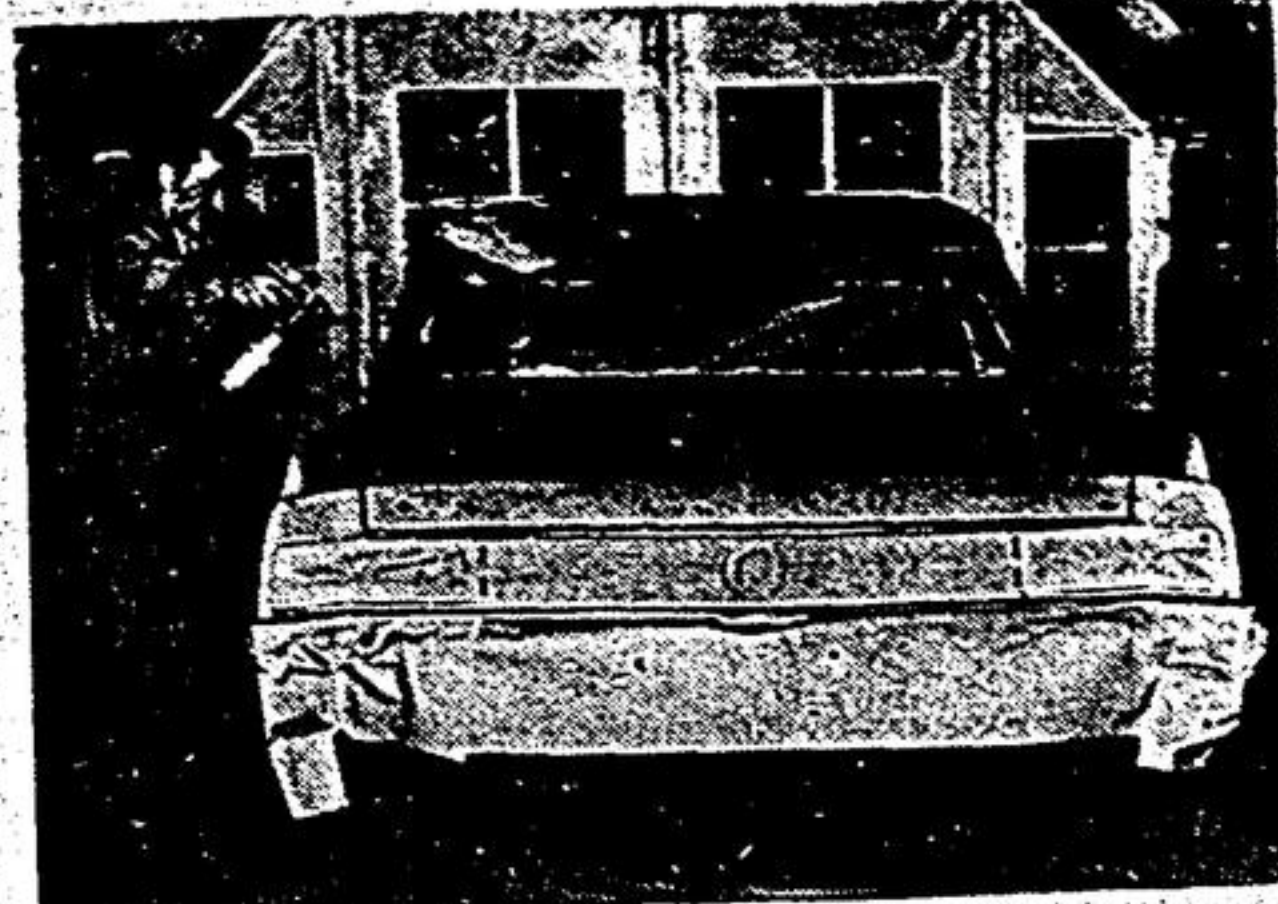
Science Fair

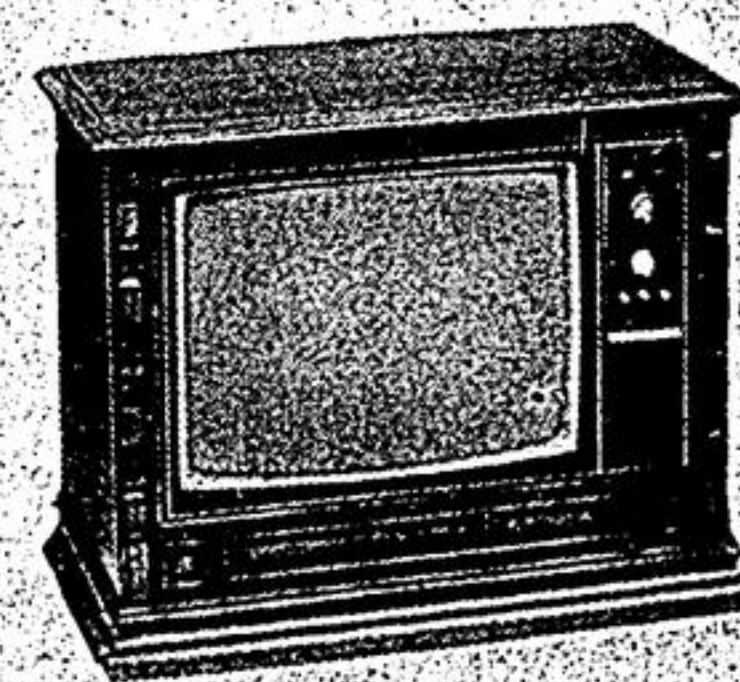
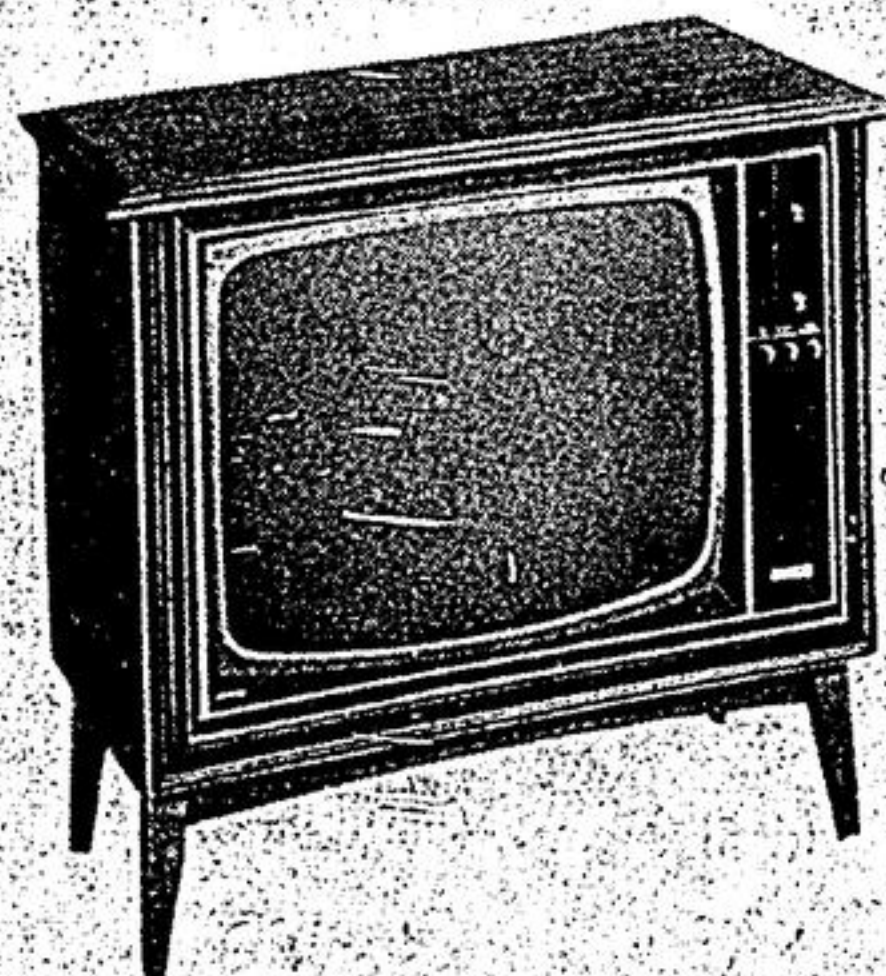

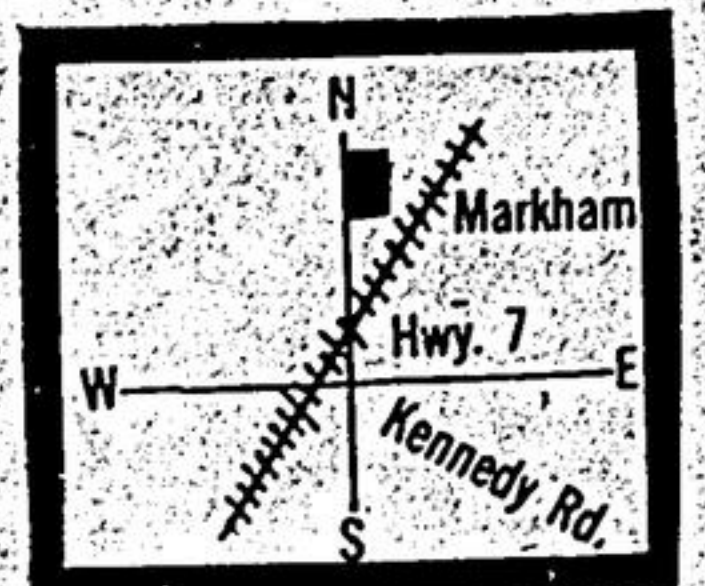
