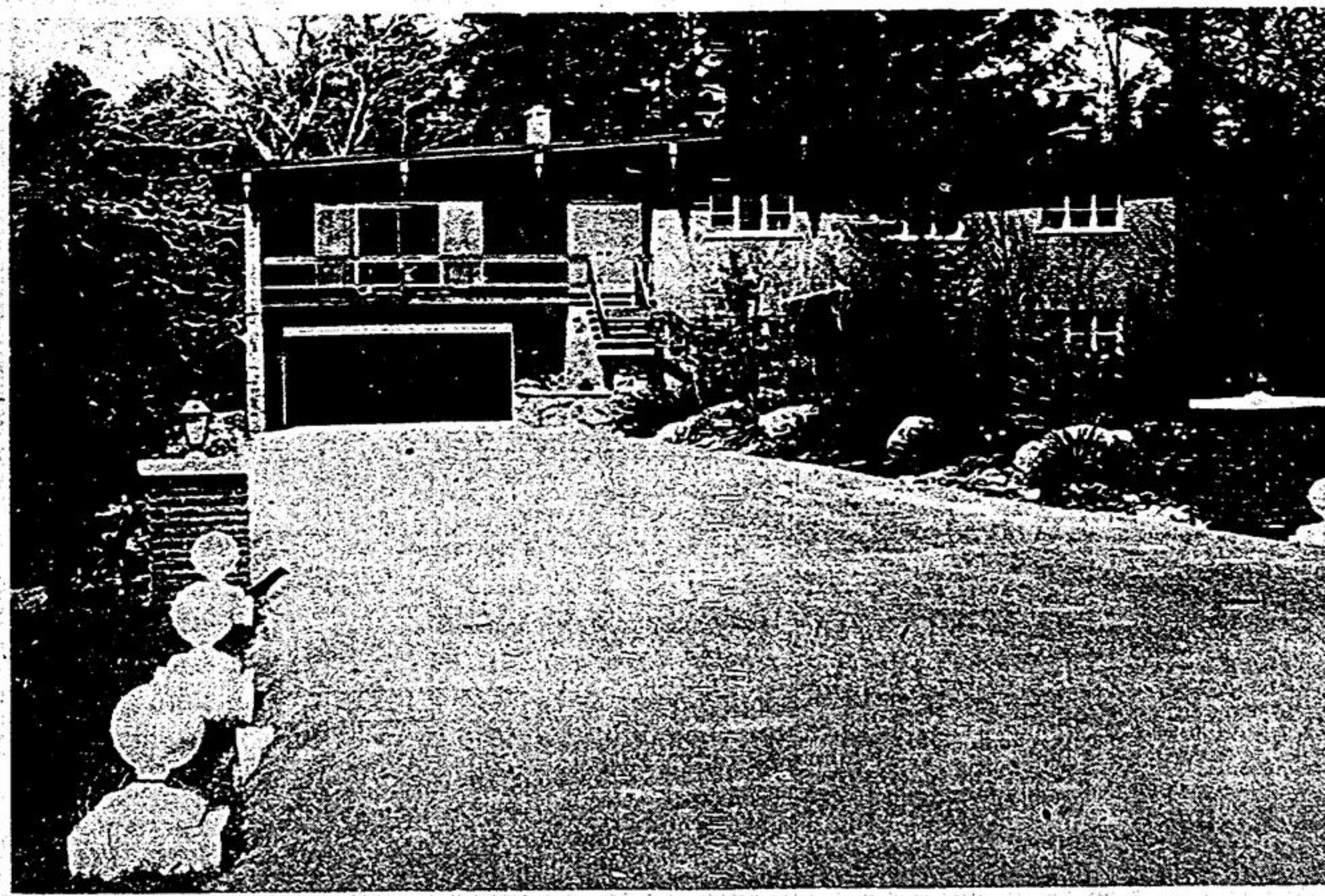

1936 Cord - star attraction

WHITEVALE - This whole community was infected by spring fever last weekend, to judge by the response to the Pickering Spring Festival.

Almost every house along the main drag sported an anti-airport sign. Some of them were highly professional jobs - "We Will Not Be Moved", "Ontario - A Place to Stand or a Place to Land", and the like. Others were humbler, hand-drawn efforts: One, which attracted a good deal of attention,

said: "Ontario Government, Beware. Enraged Family Within".

Turn of the Century dresses were everywhere, and tended to blend well with the village architecture. They went well with a partly-restored 1914 Wolseley, too.

The star of the show for many was a gleaming, silver-grey Cord 810, owned by Fred Tremere of Claremont. Built in 1936, the Cord shows 192,000 miles on its

odometer, but Mr. Tremere admits there may be a lot more than that on the car. The vehicle is completely original, down to the tail-light lens and the electric-vacuum gear pre-selector, and everything works. It's not for sale.

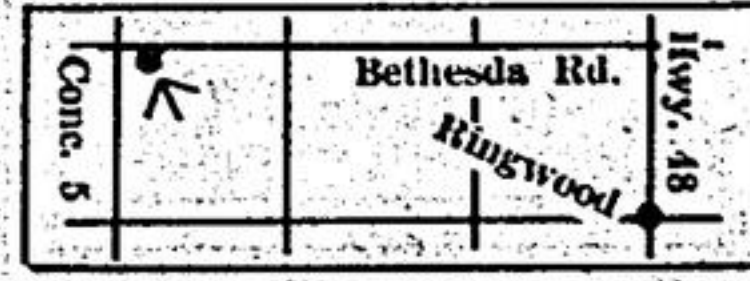

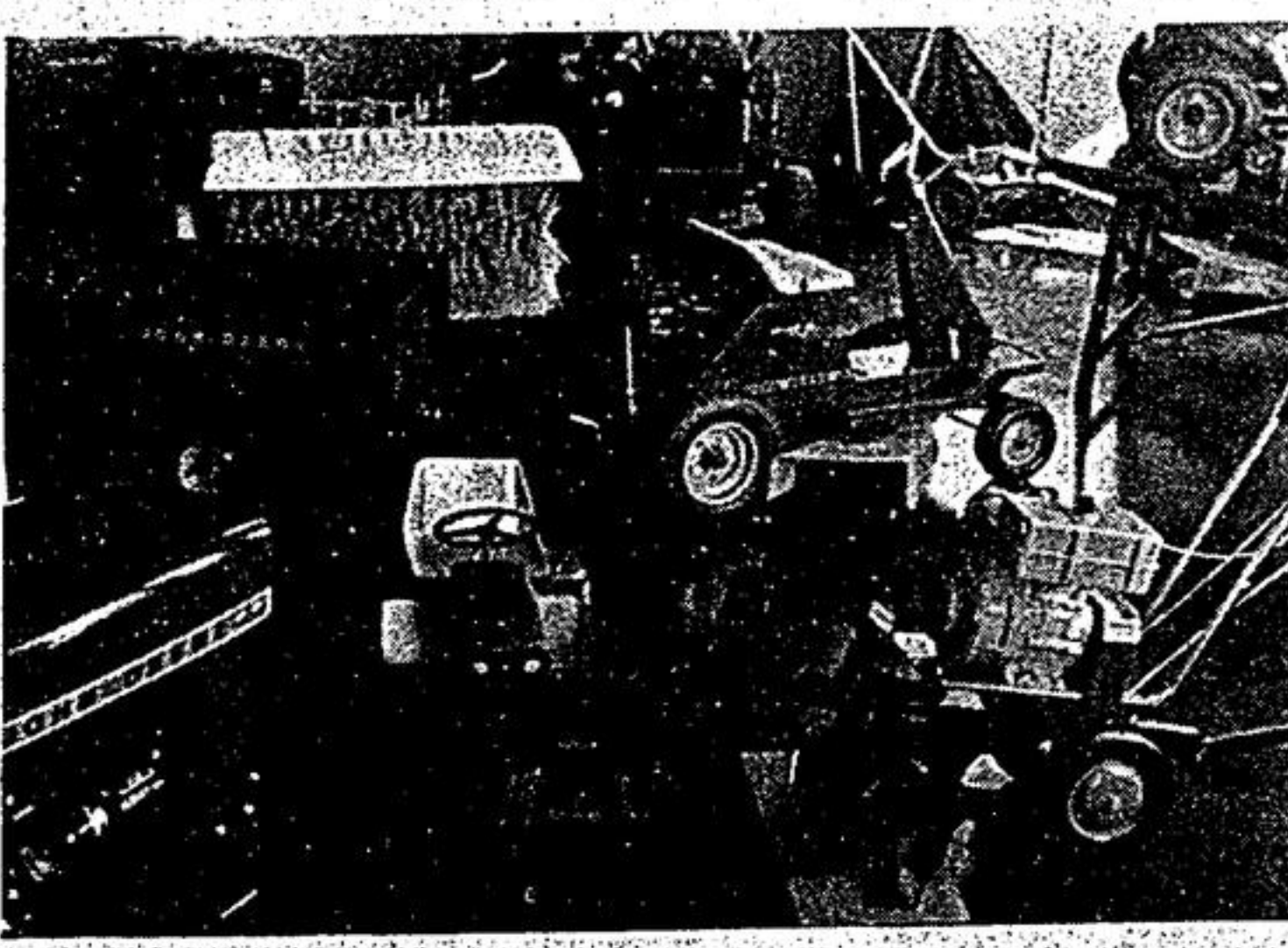

Steam Calliope

Music heard for miles

GREEN RIVER - If noise, from a 747 is anything like the noise from a steam calliope, then all of Southern Ontario will be in trouble if the Airport is built.

A gigantic, brightly-painted steam calliope was the centre of attraction at Green River School last weekend during the Pickering Spring Festival. The instrument, trucked in from the Thomson

Museum in Stratford, gave out a medley of old favorites such as "East Side, West Side", "Red River Valley", and others.

The calliope, and other features, drew large crowds to the grounds. A bake sale, held in the school, had been completely sold out twice by 3:00 Saturday - the second time, within half an hour. An Antique auction was also a popular event, and

souvenir plates depicting the famous Bentley House at Brougham sold briskly.

For most people, though, the calliope was the main thing. At a range of a few yards, the volume of sound was incredible. Mrs. Emily Williamson, a 66-year-old Toronto lady, recalled the days when, as a girl, she used to see such instruments regularly at country fairs. She stopped talking as the organ burst into "The Sidewalks of New York," and turned away, shaking her head.

"Maybe I'm not getting deaf after all," she observed.

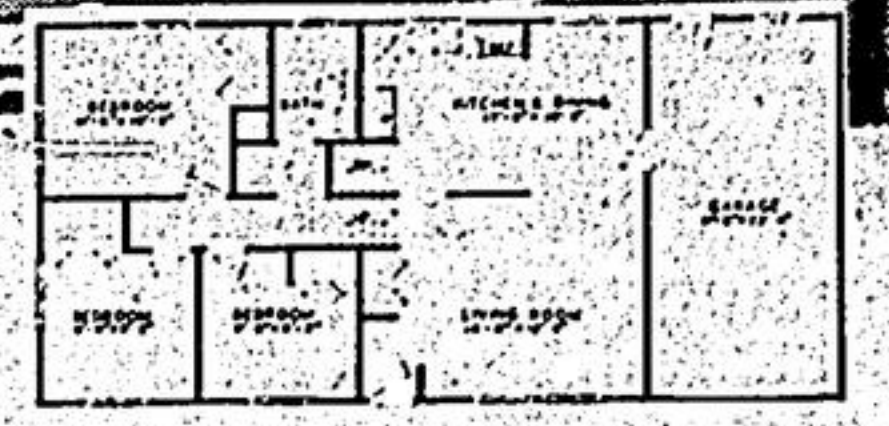
