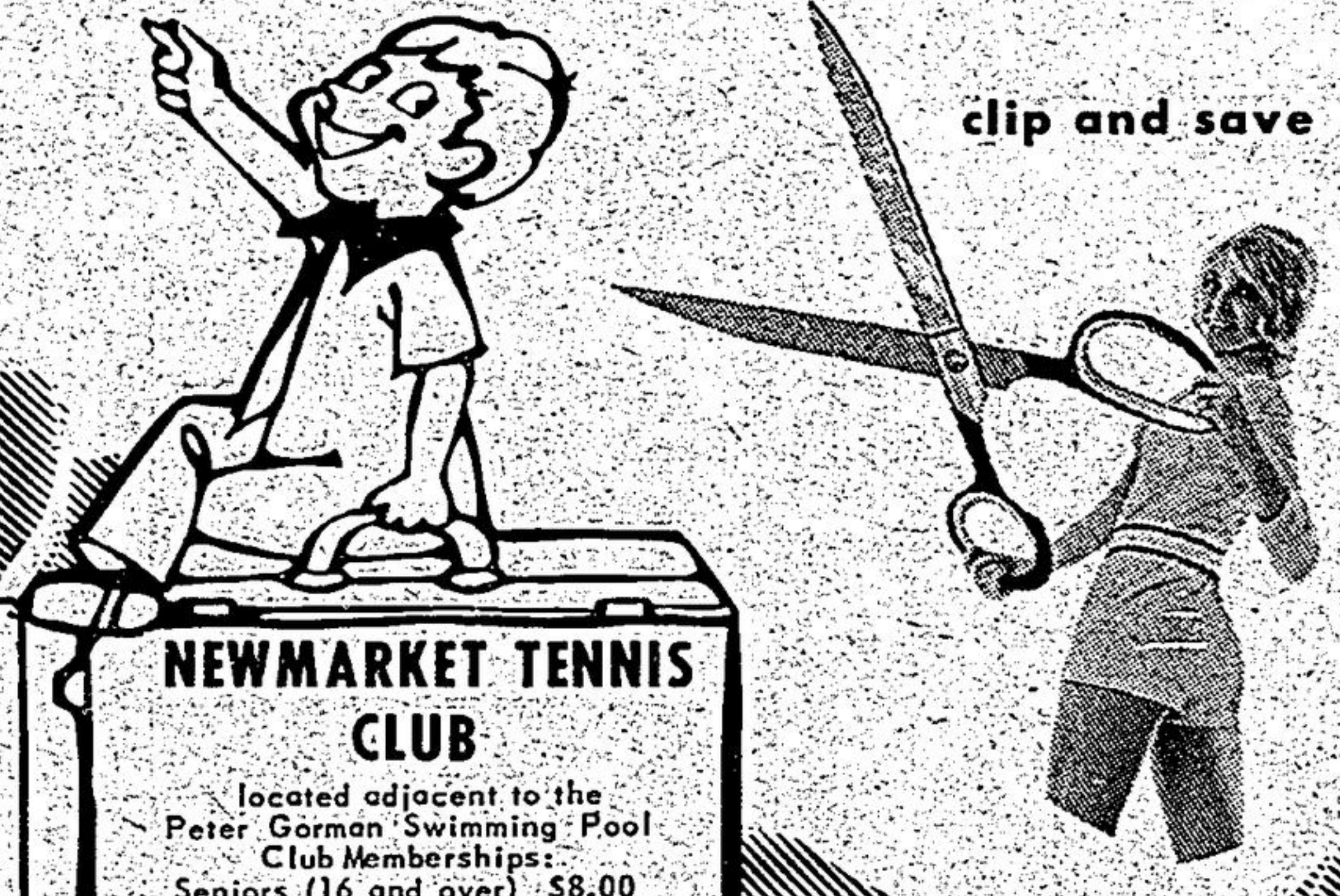

PLAYGROUNDS

A Parks Playground Program of Sports, Arts and Crafts and Special Events will take place at various Playgrounds during the 7-week period commencing July 4 through August 18. This program caters to children 5 to 15 years of age and operates Monday through Friday 9 - 12 a.m. and 4-4:30 p.m. There is no registration fee. Trained playground supervisors will staff the following playgrounds:

- Haskett Park - Millard Ave. at Queen Street
- Fairgrounds Park - Muriel and Pine Streets
- Lions Park - D'Arcy Street and Lorne Avenue
- Sunnihill Park - Queen Street East
- Rogers Park - Harrison Drive
- Dennie Park - Towercrest Drive

Special Children's Craft Classes will take place throughout the summer Playground period.

commencing July 10 through August 31. This program is aimed directly at Teenagers, consisting of Crafts, Sports, Films Discussions, etc. The program is fully supervised and is open to all Teens of the Town of Newmarket. Full details to be published in the ERA.

DAY CAMP

located at the Wesley Brooks Conservation Area (Fairy Lake)

for boys and girls 7 - 14 years

The program will be handled by trained camp staff and will consist of nature lore, hikes, camp crafts, sing songs, games and special skills. Each period will have one overnight camp (camper to supply own sleeping bag). Cost: \$10.00 per camper for each 2-week period. \$7.00 per camper for second and more children in same family.

Each camper is responsible for own transportation to and from camp and for bringing own noon lunch. Milk or juice will be provided, all equipment will be provided. Suitable camping clothes should be worn. Camp times are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for the following camping periods:

- Camp 1 - July 10 to July 21
- Camp 2 - July 24 to August 4
- Camp 3 - August 7 to August 18
- Camp 4 - August 21 to September 1

A maximum registration of 40 children per camp will be accepted on a first come - first served basis. Registration forms available at the Recreation Office.
