**DICKSON'S HILL** — Three years is a long time to wait when you want to build a house.

At a meeting, June 1, Markham Planning Committee considered an application for an amendment to the Minister's Order. It was filed by Benzik Holdings, which wish to obtain five single-family lots on the south side of 19th Avenue, east of Highway 48. The property was purchased in 1969, and a request to divide the land was made early last year. At that time, no action was taken pending preparation of a secondary plan for the Dickson's Hill area.

The request didn't get any further this year. Committee Chairman Jim Jongeneel expressed the opinion that the committee cannot approve such an application "until more definite information is available with regard to the Airport." No further action was taken.
