UNIONVILLE - The stacking of town houses, two and four storeys high, with 38 units on a 2 - acre site. was criticized 'institutional'- by Markham Mayor Tony Roman, at a meeting of Planning Committee, June 15.

The location, on the north side of Fred Varley Drive, near the entrance to Varley Village, is directly across from the Plaza. A spokesman for the development firm. said the 'stacked' type of construction was required to obtain the necessary density on the property. He admitted that reaction from local residents would undoubtedly result, necessitating a Hearing before the Ontario Municipal Board.

In keeping with the Quaker philosophy of plainness, seriousness, discipline and silence, this meeting house was a model of luxury. The building is rectangular in shape, with a single aisle inside separating the wooden benches. The whole structure is painted white with the


