Richard Day of Balsam, was able to be home on the weekend, from Fairview Lodge. Friends will be pleased to know he is coming along quite well!

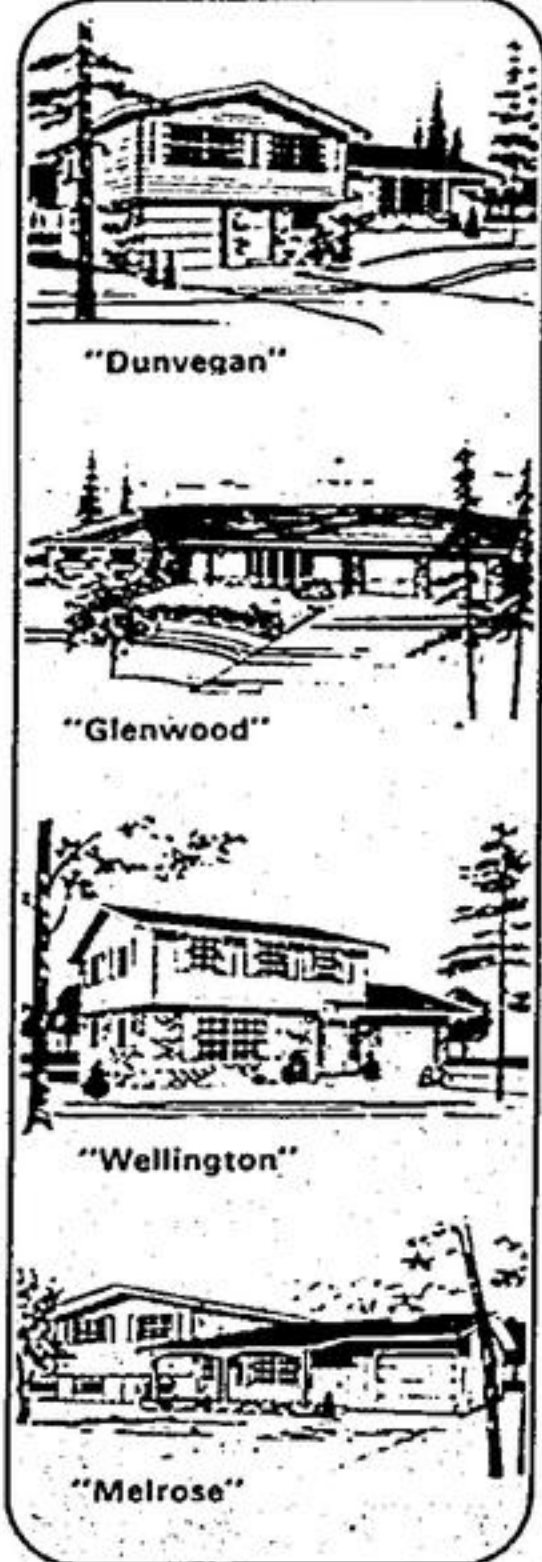
