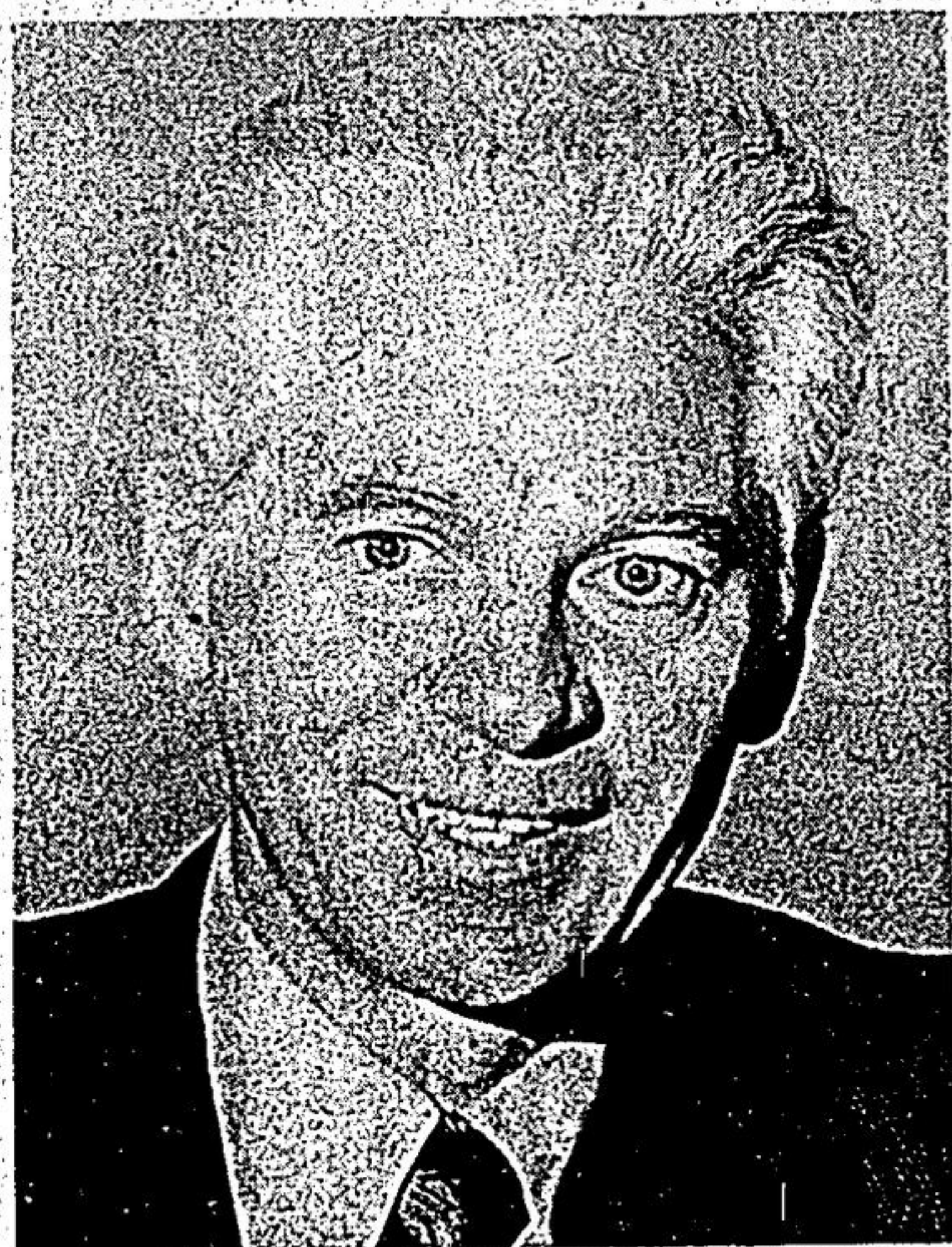
MR. ART CRAIG
