A 'real' donkey

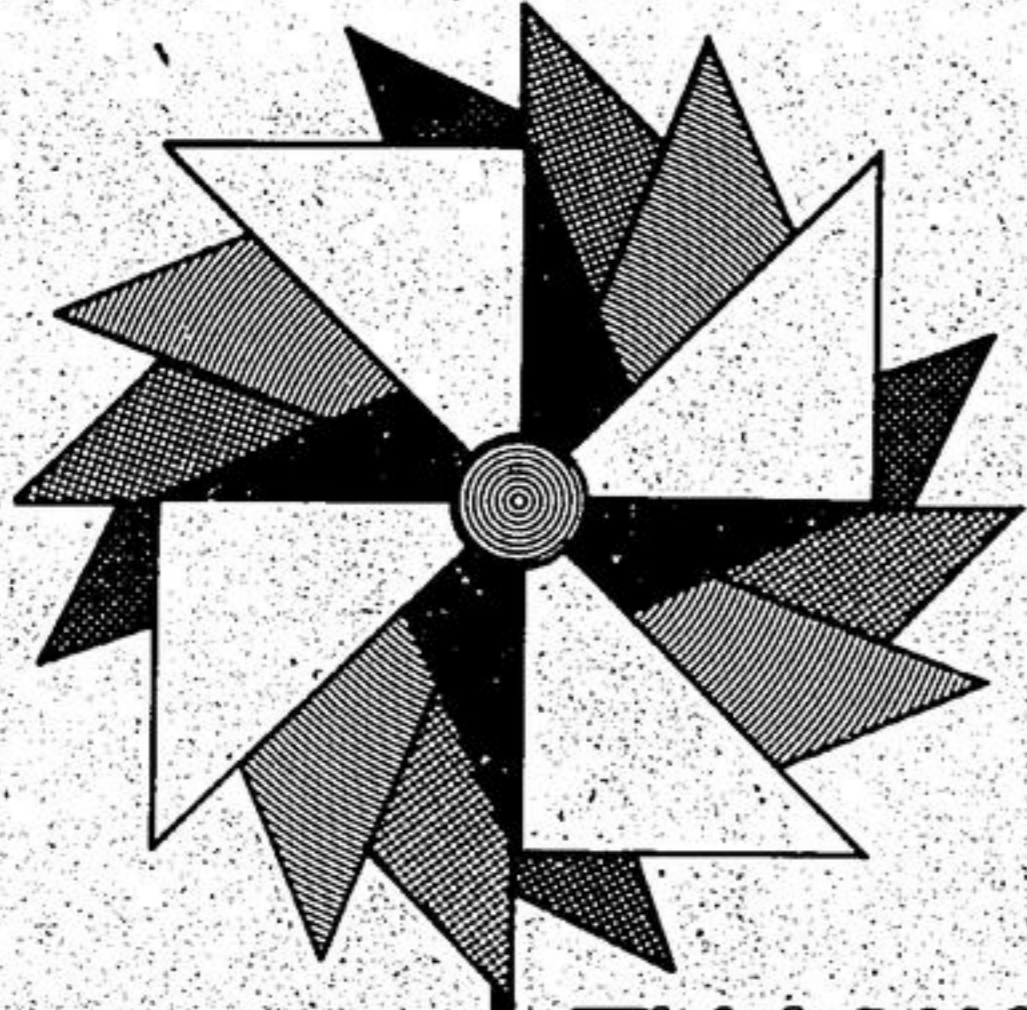
MARKHAM - There were many interesting things to see at the 117th annual Markham Fair.

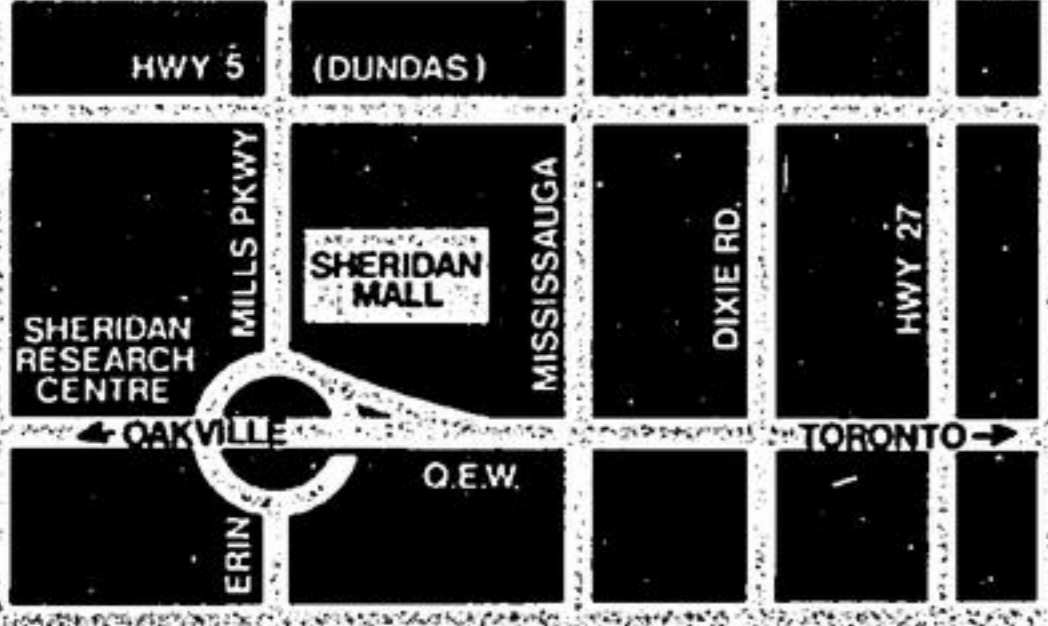
