Large area - varied problems

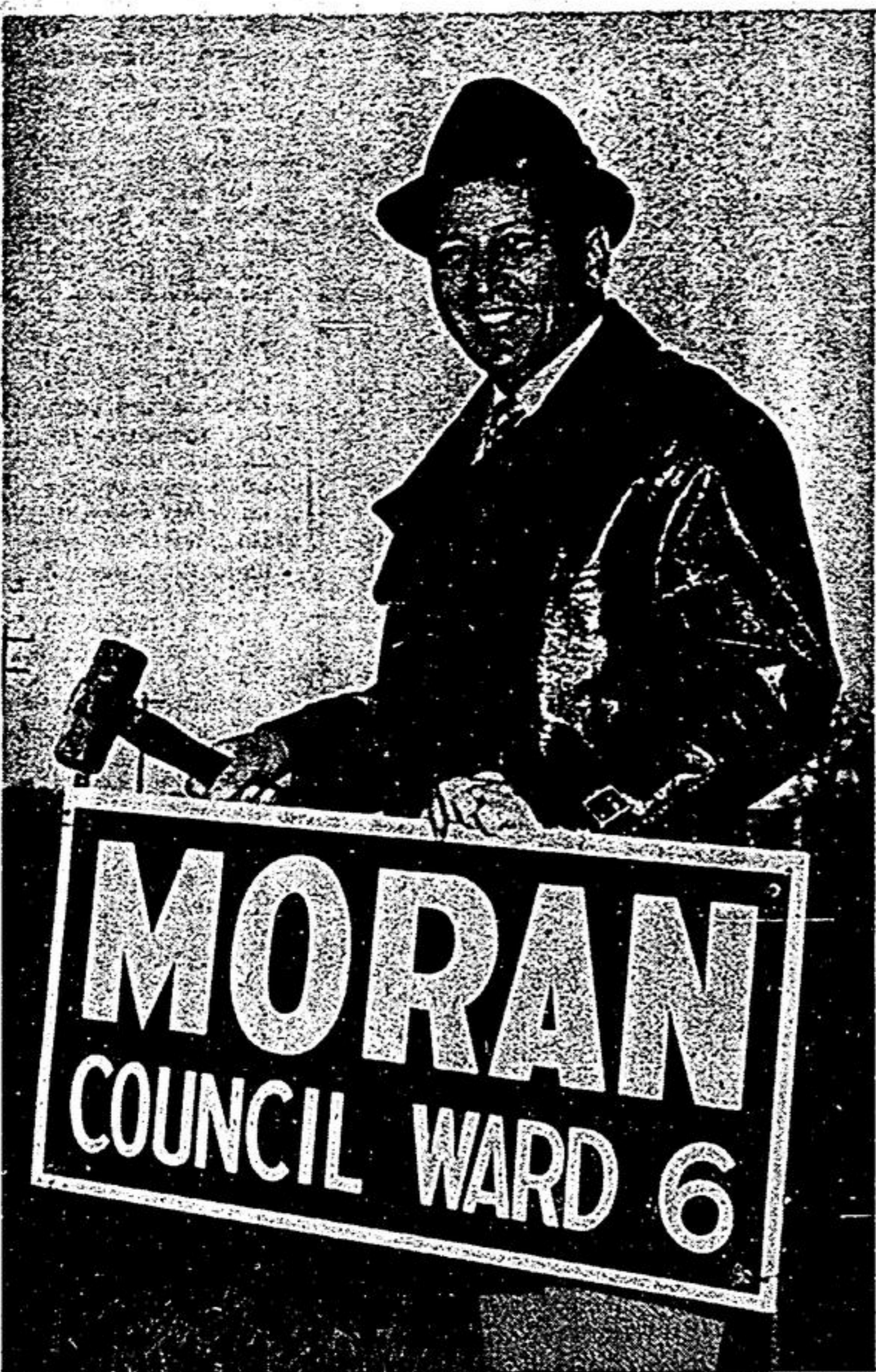
MARKHAM - At Moogolia, residents are concerned over plans for expropriation; at Mt. Joy, the main topic of conversation is mud; outside Victoria Square, pot-holes in roads are a source of irritation, and at Dickson's Hill, the problem is completing a left-hand turn onto old Hwy. 48.

These are a few of the complaints Ron Moran has heard as he makes the rounds in Ward 6. He and two other candidates, Mrs. Iga Reid, R. R. 2, Markham and Frank (Ed) Hunt, R. R. 1, Unionville, are seeking the seat currently held by councillor Norm Tyndall, R. R. 2, Gormley.

Ron Moran, 47, and father of four, resides on the cut-off service road in Dickson's Hill. Even prior to the announcement of his candidacy, he has been extremely active in the community. Now, he hopes, through election to Council, he can play an even more important role, not only in the area where he resides, but across the entire Ward.

"I hope some day to retire in this community," he said, "I want to put something back to make a contribution."

Ron Moran's main concern is for the continually rising tax rate in the Ward, with little (if any) improvements in services. He also recommends regular attendance by council members at all meetings more concern by Council for

the interests of the dwellings in Ward 6, and increased eligible voters. In 1970, about 750 of the electorate exercised their franchise. Ron Moran is confident this figure (30 percent) will improve in 1972. If an active campaign is the answer, this figure, Dec. 4, could easily double.

Pie-baking made more difficult

A pie-baking day goes something like this. Get bake board and rolling pin out. Turn around to get pie plate. While mother turns her back Number One Son climbs on table and sits on bake board.

Number Two Son swipes rolling pin and is busy rolling out dead flies. Rescue pin and board. Clean. Proceed to get ingredients together for pie shell. Flour. Chase boys and retrieve rolling pin and bake board again. Shortening. Clean up flour off walls, floor, table, stove and boys. Salt. Wipe shortening off hands, faces, walls, table and stove. Water.
