Craft school

CLAREMONT - The education committee of the Ontario County Board of Education will be considering a request for aid or facilities from a group planning to establish a craft school in Claremont.

Board Director Ken Munroe said the group had asked if the board would help with materials or providing accommodation in an unused school in the area.

The non-profit school will be for school dropouts or adults wishing to take special crafts courses, he said. Organizers have applied for an LIP grant.

Trustee Alex Williamson suggested that the board should help the venture if possible.

"I think that should be out attitude toward it."

However, Chairman Milton Mowbray said the only vacant school in the area, the Glasgow Public School, is on the land marked for expropriation for the proposed Pickering airport and North Pickering Community Project.

Host equestrians


