

R. F. 'Tommy' Farr

Promises close check on Town spending

STOUFFVILLE - R. F. 'Tommy' Farr, Glengall Lane, is an ex-councillor and former chairman of the Public Utilities Commission. Now, semi-retired, he's anxious to get back into the thick of things. He's a councillor candidate in Ward 4, Town of Whitchurch - Stouffville.

Tommy Farr has definite reasons for tossing his hat in the ring. High on the list is a promise to keep a close eye on the public purse strings. "I'll be in there to save money," he said.

What about taking politics to the people, as suggested by his opponent, Cathy Joyce?

"My door is always open and I'm as close as the telephone," he replied, "but I don't believe in hosting wine and cheese parties or listening to 'beefs' in the middle of the street. The council chambers is the proper place to air complaints."

Tommy Farr, a Stouffville resident 25 years, served one year on Council previously, and 5 years as a member of the P. U. C. The Ward 4 candidate wants no part of a Town-sponsored

municipal parking program whereby the site is financed by the municipality. "Make use of the parking areas we now have," he urged, "the trouble is, people today are too lazy to walk". He also feels that recreation facilities are sufficient

for the present, thanks to Arthur Latcham who he described as Stouffville's 'Santa Claus'.

On the subject of industry, he favors the right kind "if they come to us". "I'll have no part of coaxing

them to Town, or enticing them here with our tax money or free incentives," he stated firmly.

Traffic congestion on Main Street is a pressing problem, Tommy Farr admits. He feels the Ringwood

intersection should be adequately signed, thus giving the motorist the option of using Main Street or the Bloomington bypass. "Loaded gravel trucks," he says, "have no place in Stouffville".

Fred Lewis Seeks election again

UXBRIDGE TWP. - Fred Lewis, Altona, has been 50 years in Uxbridge Township. For 26 years he has operated Altona Feed and Supplies, a business he originated.

"We've progressed," is his comment on his successful store. "I don't see why the Township shouldn't enjoy the same growth."

And, progress through planned growth and sound management, will be Fred Lewis' predominant theme, during his election campaign, which he hopes will end in a vote establishing him as a Township councillor.

"I tried two years ago, and missed by a small margin - I'm more determined than ever to make it this time."

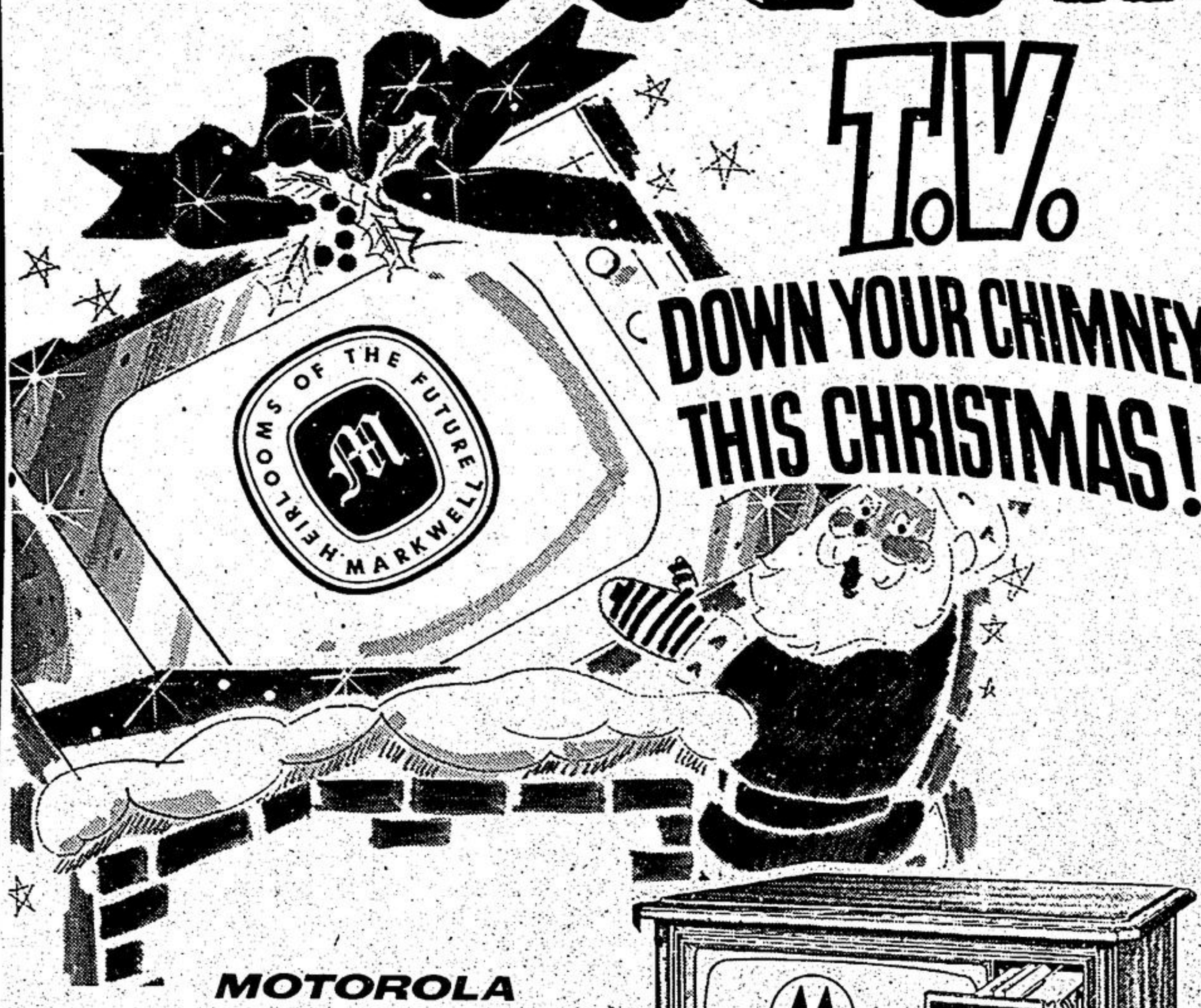

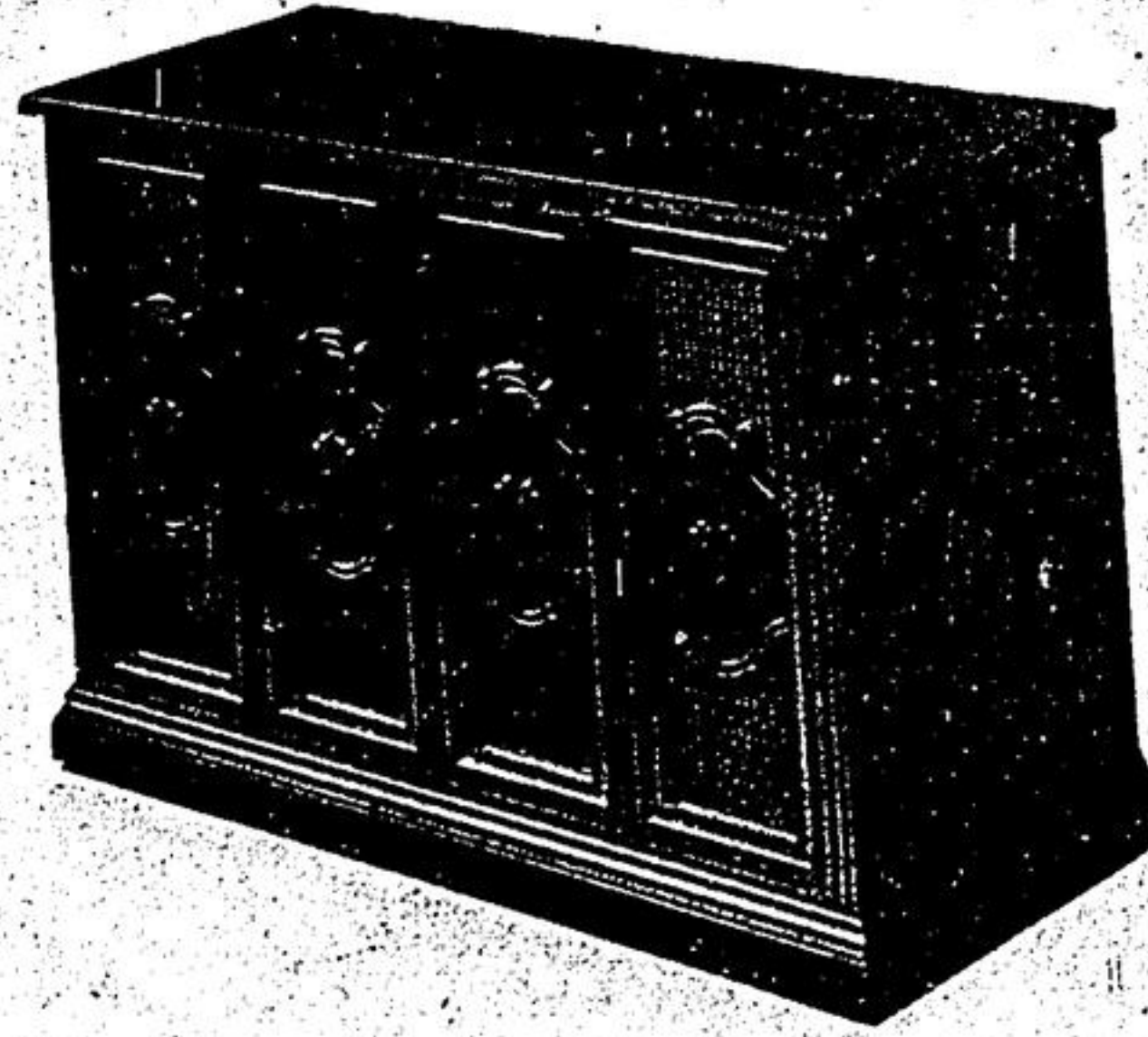
