

Sinclair Stevens

Wage-price controls

YORK - SIMCOE - Sinclair Stevens, M.P. York - Simcoe, has given his personal approval to the adoption of wage and price controls in Canada, and has expressed disappointment in the fact that the federal Liberals have not imposed restrictions of this kind.

Mr. Stevens observed that on Nov. 16, Statistics Canada reported a Price Index increase of 1.4 percent in October, taking it to a level of 9.3 percent higher than one year ago.

"In view of such inflation, it baffles me why the Trudeau government is so hesitant to impose such controls," he said.

Sinclair Stevens uses the United States as an example of how such measures can benefit the economy. He explains that between Aug. 1971 and Aug. 1972, the Index rose 2.9 percent in the U.S., while for the same period in Canada, it climbed 4.7 percent.

He notes that a 90-day wage and price freeze has also been announced for Great Britain.

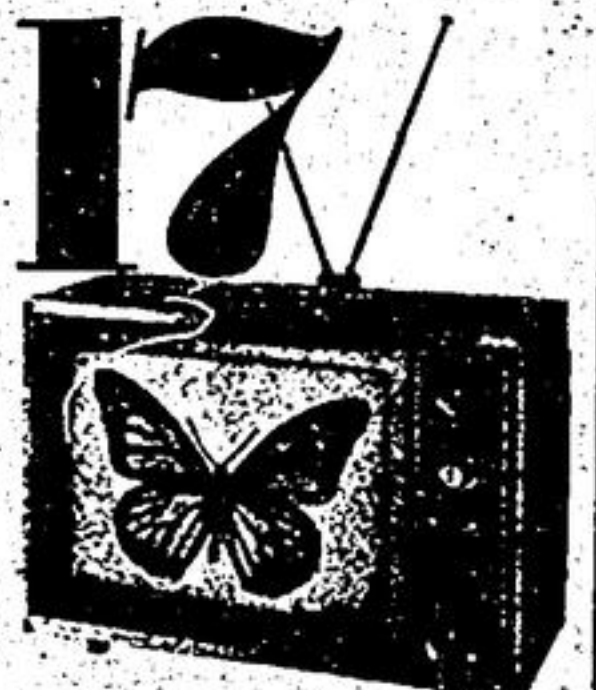
