The Minister and his Parliamentary Assistant, Donald R. Irvine, will discuss details of the proposals with municipality representatives, in the coming months.

on meat

A memo from Meat Packers' Council of Canada set down its predictions for beef and pork prices to the consumer in 1973.

The real key to Canadian price levels in beef, it states, is the U.S. situation, where cattle prices next year are expected to average close to or slightly above '72 levels.

Based on the best current information, the Council predicts continuing strong beef prices in 1973 with, perhaps, an easing of prices at the pork counters as the year progresses.




